

Articles of Incorporation of
the Abe Lincoln and Union No.

Article 1st The name of this Incorporation
and by which it shall be known
is the Abe Lincoln and Union No.
2 Gold and Silver Mining Com-
pany

Article 2nd The object of this Incorporation
and the business in which it pro-
poses to engage is the working and
development of the Quartz Lodes
known as the "Abe Lincoln and
Union No. 2" Gold and Silver bear-
ing Quartz Lodes, situate in
Carson Mining District Cuyahoga
County Idaho Territory and con-
sisting of Fourteen Hundred feet
of the "Abe Lincoln" and Five
Hundred feet of the "Union No. 2"

Article 3rd The amount of Capital Stock
of this Incorporation shall be
One Hundred and Ninety thou-
sand Dollars in Ninety hun-
dred Shares at one Hundred

), Dollars each

Article 4th The Municipal Office of this Incorporation shall be at Ruby City Cuyler County, Idaho Territory

Article 5th This Incorporation shall exist for the Term of Fifty years.

Article 6th The Board of Trustees, or managers of this Incorporation shall consist of Five, who shall transact the business of the Company for the first three months from this date and until their Successors are elected and qualified.
