#### NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

#### KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, each being of full age and a citizen of the United States of America, have associated themselves together for the purpose of amending, by addition, a section to the articles of incorporation of a non-profit corporation under Idaho Code, Title 30, Chapter 3, and in pursuance thereof do hereby sign and acknowledge the following ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT to the ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION initially filed 21 August, 1978.

#### AMENDMENT TO SECTION D

The following modification is appended to ARTICLE II, PURPOSES, as item D.

D. This organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code), and shall be distributed first to a recognized charitable museum or museums as determined in the bylaws of the corporation, next to a state or local government, and last to the federal government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the court of the county in which the principal office of 355he? corporation is then located, exclusively for such circles section to! such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, 20.00 which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

TO MODIFY THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, a quorum of the members of the corporation met in Boise, Idaho on December 11, 1992 in a special meeting called by the President for the express purpose of validating the vote to amend the articles. A written secret ballot was undertaken and completed earlier (August, 1992) by mail. The vote to amend the articles, as provided in the ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT, passed unanimously by voice vote during the special meeting, and by over a 2/3 majority vote in 90 returned ballots of 135 members in the separate mailed ballot.
