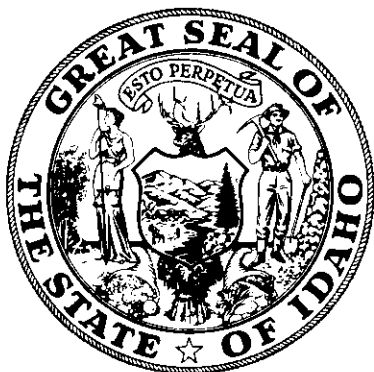

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned, all residents of the State of Idaho, and Citizens' of the United States of America, of full age of majority, have for the purpose of forming a non-profit co-operative association, under and pursuant to Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, entitled "Non-profit Co-operative Association," adopted the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE 1  
NAME

The name of the corporation: Trinity Group Homes, Inc.

ARTICLE 11  
DURATION

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 111  
PURPOSE

The purpose or purposes for which this corporation is organized are, to wit:  
To advise, operate and maintain a system of community homes for the use of severely mentally ill patients who are referred by Region 1 Mental Health Services within the counties of Benewah, Bonner, Boundary, Kootenai and Shoshone; to participate with state agencies and others in the development and implementation of programs relating to the adjustment and maintenance of such within the community; to initiate training, research and study relating to the community adjustment of mentally ill patients; to participate in public education on this subject; to serve as a charitable body for the maintenance of mentally ill patients when necessary; to make provision for research and consultation in the area of community adjustment of mentally ill patients; and in general, to do all acts and things necessary and proper to facilitate the adjustment within the community of severely mentally ill persons. The Trinity Group Homes is open to all mentally ill referrals regardless of race, creed, or origin.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

ARTICLE IV  
POWERS

The Corporation shall have all powers granted non-profit corporations under the laws of the State of Idaho. However, notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended. The corporation shall have the incidental powers to do everything necessary, suitable, or proper for the accomplishment, attainment, or furtherance of, to do every other act or thing incidental to, apparent to, growing out of, or connected with the purposes, objects, or powers set forth in these Articles of Incorporation, whether alone or in association with others; to possess all rights, powers, and privileges now or hereafter conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho upon a non-profit co-operative association organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and, in general, to carry on any of the activities and to do any of the things herein set forth to the same extent and as fully as a mutual person or partnership might or could do; provided that nothing herein set forth shall be construed as authorizing the Corporation to possess any purpose, object, or power, or to do any act or thing forbidden by law to a non-profit co-operative association organized under the laws of the State of Idaho or a tax exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

ARTICLE V  
MEMBERSHIP

Any person may become a member of this corporation by agreeing to comply with and be bound by these Articles of Incorporation and by the By-laws, together with any amendments thereto and such rules and regulations as may be from time to time adopted by the members.

ARTICLE VI  
DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors. The qualifications for directors shall be set forth in the By-laws. The Board shall consist of 5 persons. The Board may delegate authority of conducting business to its various committees.

ARTICLE VII  
ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Directors of the Corporation shall be elected in the manner provided by the By-laws.

ARTICLE VIII

ARTICLE X  
DISTRIBUTION OR DISSOLUTION
