ARTICLE FOURTEEN

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF GRORPORATION .
OF THE LATAH COUNTY HUMANE SOCIETY

On June 19, 1979, a special meeting of the Latah County Human Society was held in Room 2-B of the Latah County Courthouse. A quorum was present. Notification of the meeting was sent to all voting members by mail 60 days prior to the meeting. Members were informed that for us to apply for tax exempt status, the society must adopt the following articles of amendment. By unamimous vote the membership passed the articles of amendment.

These amended articles are in addition to the original articles.

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and has an objective of prevention of cruelty to animals.
