

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION,
OF THE

"LOWER BOISE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION."

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the members of the "Lower Boise Cemetery Association", of Lower Boise, Canyon County, State of Idaho have voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Idaho, and Now Therefore, this is to Certify:

That a meeting of said Association was duly called and regularly held at The Tucker School House, in Lower Boise Precinct, Canyon County, State of Idaho, on the 24th day of July, 1903, for the purpose of electing three members thereof to constitute a Board of ^{Directors} ~~Trustees~~ of the said Cemetery Association. That Frank C. Gilbert and Bertha Petersen were selected by the members of said association to act as Chairman, and Secretary, respectively, of the said meeting; and that the said parties did so act and conduct the said election; and that a majority of all the members of said association were present at the said meeting and voted in the said election, and the result thereof was the choice and election of Z. S. Barnum, H. S. Stockton, and H. S. G. Petersen, as members to constitute the said Board of ^{Directors} ~~Trustees~~ for the said Association for the first year, and for the purpose of drafting, executing, and filing the necessary Articles of Incorporation; and Now, Therefore, this is to Certify further:

1. That the name of this Corporation shall be: "LOWER BOISE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION."

2. That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a). To provide, maintain, and keep in suitable condition a place for the burial of the dead:

(b). To acquire, hold, transfer, and convey all property, both real and personal, that may be necessary as a means to accomplish the said purposes: and

(c). To make all contracts, both negotiable and non-negotiable and to execute equitable contracts and conveyances to more perfectly insure the performance thereof:

3. That the place where the principal business of this corporation is to be transacted shall be Lower Boise, Canyon County, Idaho.

4. That the term during which this Corporation shall exist shall be fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

5. That the number of ^{Directors} ~~Trustees~~ of this Corporation shall be Three, and that the names and residences of those elected for the first year are: NAMES. RESIDENCES.

6. That the amount of the capital stock shall be none.
