in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated,
do hereby certify as follows:

hereinafter named: **II**
That the corporation shall be nonstock and no dividends
or pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof.

That the voting power of the corporation shall be determined
as follows: The undersigned have associated, and by these presents do
hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming this
corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 14 of the Idaho
Code, to form a corporation and association for the establishment,
maintenance and management of facilities for worship, including the
necessary buildings, structures, lands and properties for places of
worship, and to acquire, own and possess by donation, gift, bequest,
device or purchase, and to hold and maintain property, whether real,
personal or mixed, and to grant, sell, convey, rent or otherwise dis-
pose of the same as may be necessary to carry on or to promote the
objects of this corporation; to provide for the poor, to establish
and provide Missions, and in pursuance of the objects of this corpora-
tion to borrow money and execute written obligations therefor, and to
do all other things of every kind whatsoever which the purpose of this


