ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the laws of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be C&S Investment
Co., Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The period of existence and the duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The nature of the business and the object and purpose of this corporation shall be:

(a) To investigate, develop, consummate, undertake, or carry on any enterprise, business, transaction or operation of any financial, commercial, industrial, agriculture or other nature, calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho; and to generally institute, enter into, carry on, assist, promote and participate in any act, enterprise or vocation that a natural person might or could do, but only to the extent permitted by law.

(b) To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, invest in, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, lease, assign and transfer or otherwise dispose of, trade, deal in and deal with goods, wares and merchandise and personal property of every class and description and to render services of all kinds.

(c) To purchase, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, exchange or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every kind and description, including but not limited to shares of stock, bonds, debentures, notes, evidences of indebtedness, and other securities, contracts or obligations of any corporation or corporations, association or associations, domestic or foreign, and to pay therefor in whole or in part in cash or by exchanging stocks, bonds, or other evidences of indebtedness or securities of this or any other corporation, and while the owner or holder of any such real or personal property, stocks, bonds, debentures, notes, evidences of indebtedness of other securities, contracts, or obligations, to receive, collect, and dispose of the interest, dividends and income arising from such property, and to possess and exercise in respect thereof, all the rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including all voting powers on any stocks so owned.

(d) To enter into, make and perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, firm, association or corporation, municipality, body politic, country, territory, district, state, and government.

(e) To purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bond, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by, any other corporation or corporations organized under the laws of this state or any other state, country, nation, or government, and while the owner thereof to exercise all the right, powers, and privileges of ownership.

(f) To apply for, secure, acquire by assignment, transfer, purchase or otherwise, and to exercise, carry out and enjoy any charter, license, power, authority, franchise, concession, rights or privileges, which any government or authority or any corporation or other public body may be empowered to grant; and to pay for, aid in, and contribute

toward carrying the same into effect, and to appropriate any of the corporations shares of stock, bonds and assets to defray the necessary costs, charges and expenses thereof.

(g) To borrow money or otherwise incur indebtedness without limit as to the amount, and to draw, make, accept, endorse, transfer, assign, guarantee, execute and issue bonds, debentures, notes, drafts, bills of exchange, negotiable instruments: and all other instruments for the payment of money, negotiable and non-negotiable, secured and unsecured.

(h) To purchase or other wise acquire the whole of any part of the property assets, business and good will of any other person, firm, corporation or association, and to conduct in any lawful manner the business so acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient for the conduct, management and carrying on of such business.

(i) To purchase, insofar as the same may be done without impairing the capital of this corporation, except as otherwise prohibited by law, and to hold, pledge and reissue shares of its own capital stock, but such stock so acquired and held shall not be entitled to vote nor to receive dividends.

(j) To have, exercise, enjoin and participate in all the powers now or hereafter granted to corporations organized under the laws of this state, and particularly all of the powers and privileges granted to corporations under Chapter 1, Title 30, Idaho Code, including any future amendments thereto, and to do any act or things necessary or convenient for the transaction of the aforesaid business or businesses and for the carrying into effect of any and all the aforesaid objects and purposes.

(k) To carry on any of the foregoing or closely related businesses as principal, agent, lessors, lessees, assigners, assignees, licensees, or otherwise which can be generally carried on in connection with any of the pursuits aforesaid.

ARTICLE IV.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be in the amounts of \$5,000 divided into 5,000 shares of non-assessable common stock of the par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE V.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho, at 502 South 5th St., which is hereby designated as the address of its registered office.

ARTICLE VI.

ARTICLE VII.

The management of this corporation shall be vested in a board of not less than three directors and a maximum number as may be fixed by the By-Laws. The directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the stockholders, to be held at the time and place designated by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

The Board of Directors of this corporation shall provide for adoption of By-Laws as provided by the laws of this State. The Board of Directors shall set a time and place for annual meeting of shareholders

as provided by the laws of this State. A regular meeting of shareholders or a special meeting of shareholders of the corporation may be called at any time by those persons representing a majority of the allotted shares of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX.

The private property of the stockholders of this corporation shall not be subject to the payment of the corporate debts in any amount or to extent whatever.
