

Blondeau, being over the age of 18 years and a citizen of the United States of America, hereby makes and files these Articles of Incorporation with the purposes of establishing a corporation for the transaction of the business and the promotion and conduct of the objects and purposes herein stated under the laws of the State of Idaho and hereby certifies as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation (hereinafter referred to as "the corporation") is Blondeau Properties, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act and generally to carry on any business and have all powers conferred by the State of Idaho upon a corporation formed under its laws.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have the authority to issue 1,000 shares of common stock with no par value, which shall qualify as \$1244 stock, Internal Revenue Code. All of said stock shall be voting common stock of one single class having equal rights, powers and preferences.

ARTICLE V

The incorporator of the corporation is August B. Blondeau, 3514 219th Place S.E., Issaquah, Washington 98029.

ARTICLE VI
