In the matter of the application by petition of H.A. Grover, J.H. Warner and 100 others for the incorporation of the Village of Parker, the Board finds the following to be the facts:

First

That the metes and bounds of the proposed Village are as follows:

Commencing <sup>at point 20 rods West of</sup> at the South east corner of the S  $1\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4 Twp. 7 N.R. 40 E. & M. Fremont County Idaho running thence North 20 rods, thence West 80 rods, thence North 140 rods, thence West 40 rods, thence North 160 rods, thence West 40 rods, thence South 160 rods, thence West 70 rods, thence South 140 rods, thence West 230 rods, thence South 40 rods, thence East 300 rods, thence South 200 rods, thence East 40 rods, thence North 100 rods thence East 60 rods, thence North 100 rods, thence East 60 rods, thence North 20 rods to place of beginning, being parts of Section 4, 5, 8 and 9 of Twp 7 N.R. 40 E. & M.

Second

That there are now residing within said described Territory more than 200 bona fide resident

Third

That a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the above described Territory, have duly signed the petition for the incorporation of said Territory into a Village.

Fourth

That the name they wish to assume for said Village is Parker.

Fifth

We therefore declare the above described Territory incorporated the Village of Parker, and this order of Incorporation shall be spread upon the Commissioners Journal, and we hereby appoint H.A. Miller, H.A. Grover, H.L. Flint, E.D. Stevenson

and A. D. Miller, Jr., (each being over 21 years of age, a tax payer, and each an inhabitant of said Village,) Trustees of said Village who shall hold their office, and perform the duties thereof, until the lawful election and qualification of their successors.

It appearing to the Board that in the year 1903, George R. Lister was assessed for and paid taxes on NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 26 Twp 4 St. R. 39 E. & P. M. and it further appearing that said land was also assessed to H. E. McDonald and sold to the County for said tax, it is hereby ordered that said sale be cancelled, being a double assessment.

*Taxes*  
Whereas in the year 1896, Hymen Delnap was the owner of and paid taxes on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 33 Twp. 7 St. R. 40 E. & P. M. and whereas the said property was assessed to H. M. Parker, Sr., and sold to County for Delinquent Taxes, it is hereby ordered that said Tax Sale be cancelled, being a double assessment.

*Taxes*  
It appearing from Tax Receipt #880 that P. Fransen paid his Poll Tax for 1903, and it appearing that his property was sold for said Poll Tax, the said tax Sale is cancelled.

Ordered that this Board do now adjourn until to morrow at 9 o'clock A.M.
