ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all full-age citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit organization under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify;

- ARTICLE 1: The name of this corporation shall be Amateur Radio Operators of Idaho, Inc.
- ARTICLE 2: The purposes for which this corporation is being formed are: to provide communications in the interest of public service, to cooperate to the fullest extent of our abilities with the Idaho Department of Disaster Relief and Civil Defense, or any other group needing auxiliary communications, and to promote interest in the advancement of amateur radio.
- ARTICLE 3: In this association the rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest than any other member. This association shall not issue any capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of this association. Any radio amateur of the State of Idaho shall be eligible to membership in this corporation upon complying with the by-laws thereof.
- ARTICLE 4: This corporation shall have power; to purchase, rent, lease, or in any manner acquire, own and hold real and personal property convenient for the purpose of carrying out the objects and purposes of this corporation as herein above specified, and to mortgage, sell or convey said property, or any part thereof, or to lease or demise the same; to borrow money upon the security of the property of this corporation now owned or subsequently acquired and generally to deal with the property of this corporation as fully and to the same extent as might be done were such property individually owned; to give public and private lectures, exhibitions, and instructions and to appoint instructors and agents suitable or necessary for the carrying out of the purposes and aims of this corporation.
- ARTICLE 5: The principle place of business and location of this corporation shall be the city of Boise, Ada County, Idaho.
- ARTICLE 6: The private property of the members of this corporation shall not be liable for its corporate debts.
- ARTICLE 7: The number of directors shall be five.
- ARTICLE 8: The operations of this association shall not be for pecuniary profit to this association or to its members, but shall be for the mutual benefit of the members.
- ARTICLE 9: The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.
