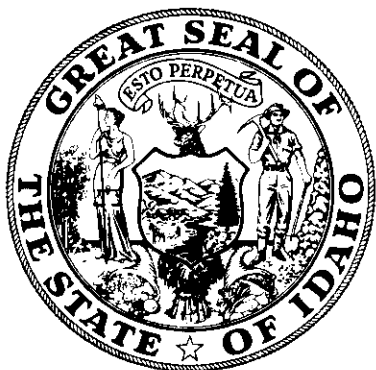

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
SECRETARY OF

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a non-profit corporation under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for this non-profit corporation:

I.

The name of this non-profit corporation shall be Citizens Association for Lake Environment, Inc.

II.

The period of existence and duration of the life of this non-profit corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The address of the initial registered office of this non-profit corporation is 1010 First Interstate Bank Building, Boise, Idaho, 83701 and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is United States Corporation Company.

IV.

The nature of the business and the object and purpose of this non-profit corporation shall be as follows:

To preserve and protect the aesthetic and environmental qualities of Big Payette Lake and its environs, and to protect the value of property in the McCall and Big Payette Lake areas.

V.

The designation of the classes of members, manner of appointment and the qualifications and rights of the members of each class is set forth in the bylaws.

VI.

The name and post office address of the incorporator is as follows:

The first Board of Directors shall consist of three (3) directors, but during their term of office, or thereafter, the number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time as may be provided by the By-Laws; provided, however, that the number of directors constituting a Board shall not be less than three (3) nor more than nine (9).


VIII.
