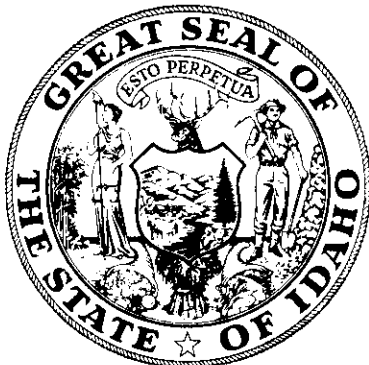

TO: PETE CENARRUS , SECRETARY OF STATE IN AND FOR THE STATE OF IDAHO

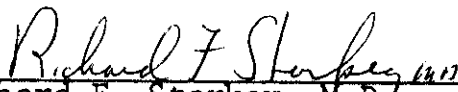

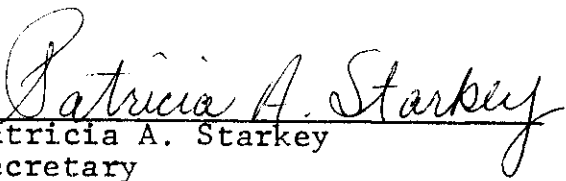
