

Articles of Incorporation of the Valley Water Works Company.

Know all men by these presents that we the undersigned have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the Laws of the Territory of Idaho, a corporation to be known by the corporate name of The Valley Water Works Company.

And we hereby certify that the objects for which this corporation is formed are the acquiring of Water Rights conveying water through pipes and other conduits to the town of Ketchikan and adjacent property in the County of Alturas in said Territory and of selling water to the inhabitants of the said town etc. for domestic uses, irrigation, manufacturing the working of ores, extinguishing fires, and generally for any and all useful and beneficial purposes for which water may be used. And to that end, to acquire lands, construct reservoirs, lay and maintain pipes lines and generally to do any and all things necessary or expedient to be done in carrying out any and all of the aforesaid purposes and

objects of said Corporation.

That the principal place of business shall be at the town of Ketchum county of Alturas, Territory of Idaho. That the time of its existence shall be Fifty years.

That the Amount of the Capital Stock of said Corporation shall be Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars divided into Sixty Thousand (60,000) Shares of the par value of one (\$1) dollar each.

That the number of Trustees who shall manage the affairs and concerns of the company for the first three months is Five and that the names of such Trustees are,
