CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF MOUNTAIN VIEW IRRIGATION COMPANY, INC.

This is to certify that a special meeting of the Board of Directors of the Mountain View Irrigation Company, Inc., a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, was held on the 28th day of March, 1975, in Twin Falls, Idaho, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the by-laws of said company; that a quorum of directors of said company was present and that at said meeting the following resolution was proposed:

WHEREAS, The first paragraph on page one of the Articles of Incorporation of Mountain View Irrigation Company, Inc declares the purpose of forming the corporation to be pecuniary profit; and

WHEREAS, The true purpose of this company is to serve its members only, and therefore the stock can have no value by itself due to the nature of the business of the company, and that for each acre of land owned or to be acquired pursuant to Desert Land Entry or Carey Act the shareholders shall be entitled to delivery of one share of water, and

WHEREAS, The company has acquired water rights from the Department of Reclamation of the State of Idaho in the Snake River, in Twin Falls County, Idaho, and desires to raise capital to put this water to a beneficial use by issuing a portion of its authorized shares under an exemption from

registration within the Idaho Securities Act, to-wit, Idaho Code 30-1434(12); and


WHEREAS, A majority of the stockholders of Mountain View Irrigation Company, Inc. have signed a written consent of stockholders to amendment of the Articles of Incorporation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the first paragraph on page one of the Articles of Incorporation be amended to read that Mountain View Irrigation Company, Inc. is a co-operative association and a non-profit corporation formed under the laws of the State of Idaho for purposes which do not include pecuniary profit as an object.

In May of this year, the corporation, desiring to issue more securities, attempted to obtain an exemption under the Idaho Securities Act. The exemption was denied because the corporation, which at all times has been intended to be a non-profit corporation, had inadvertently provided in its articles that it was organized for profit.

We have filed the enclosed papers with you in order to formally declare the purpose of the corporation to be non-profit in order to be exempt under Idaho Code 30-1434(12) as a cooperative corporation organized pursuant to Idaho Code 30-117(a).
