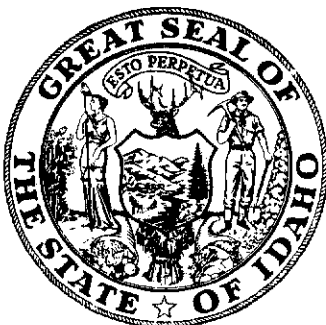

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural citizens of full age and citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the general laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be "DOUBLE J FARMS, INC.".

ARTICLE II

The Corporation's purposes are to conduct whatever business or to perform whatever actions are allowed by the State of Idaho for profit corporations.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the Corporation's registered office in this state shall be 1825 E. 3700 N. Buhl, Idaho. That Jon G. Kimball shall be the registered agent, whose address is 1825 E. 3700 N. Buhl, Idaho.

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ARTICLE V

The total number of shares which the Corporation is authorized to issue is 1,000 shares. Said shares shall have no par value.

ARTICLE VII

(A) The Board of Directors shall consist of two (2) Directors. During the term of their office, or thereafter, the number of Directors shall be increased or decreased from time to time as provided by the By-Laws; provided, however, that the Board of Directors shall not be more than five (5) nor less than two (2).

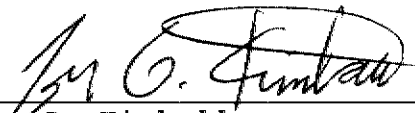
ARTICLE IX

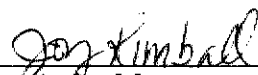
The authorized and treasury stock of this corporation may be issued at such time, upon such terms and conditions and for such consideration that the Board of Directors shall determine.
