KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, DWIGHT HORSCH, CHESTER WAHLEN, DAVID WAHLEN, KIM WAHLEN, and VAL F. WAHLEN, all of Bingham County, Idaho, all of whom are over the age of eighteen years, and whose names are hereunto subscribed, do under and pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act for the purpose of becoming a body corporate and carrying on all of the businesses hereinafter mentioned, and doing all things and acts necessary, convenient or beneficial thereto, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME:

The name of this corporation shall be BIG V MACHINE, INC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES:

The purposes for which this corporation is formed and the pursuits for which it may carry on shall be, (1) to engage in any and all forms of machinery and equipment repair, machine shop fabrication, equipment modification, sale of parts, equipment and machinery rebuilding, (2) to engage in any and all types of wholesale and/or retail sale of real and/or personal property of every type and description, (3) to engage in rentals or leases of real and/or personal property of every type and description, (4) to engage in short and/or long term financing of real and/or personal property of every type and description, (5) to engage in any and all other types of business activities as fully and to the same extent as natural persons of this State might or could do and perform any and all of these functions in this state or in any part of the world.

Said corporation shall be empowered to engage in any or all of the foregoing by acquiring, purchasing, renting, owning, leasing, or otherwise operating, managing or controlling the foregoing pursuits in any manner deemed advisable by the Corporation.

To borrow money of any person, firm or corporation, and to issue bonds, debentures, or obligations of this corporation from time to time for any of the objects or purposes of the corporation and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or by any other lawful means.

To enter into, make and perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, firm, association, or corporation, municipality, body politic, county, territory, state, government or colony or dependency thereof, and without limit as to amount, to draw, make accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds debentures, and other negotiable or transferable instruments and evidences of indebtedness whether secured by mortgage or otherwise, as well as to secure the same by mortgage or otherwise, so far as may be permitted by the laws of the State of Idaho.

To purchase, acquire and own its shares of stock, but shares of such capital stock so purchased or acquired may not be resold unless such shall have been retired for the purpose of decreasing the company's capital stock as provided by law.

To do each and every thing necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any one or more to the objects herein enumerated, or which shall at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of this corporation.

In general, to carry on any other lawful business whatsoever in connection with the foregoing to which is calculated directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the value of its properties.

ARTICLE III

REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT:

ARTICLE IV

EXISTENCE:

This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner disincorporated according to law.

ARTICLE V

GOVERNING PROVISIONS:

All provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are such as may be provided by the by-laws of the corporation, including provision for restriction on transfer of shares, as provided in the Idaho Business Corporation Act, Section 30-1-23A.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS:

That the corporate powers, business and property of this corporation shall be exercised, conducted and controlled by a Board of Directors composed of not less than five members. The incorporators, whose names are subscribed hereto and listed in Article VIII hereof shall act as the directors of this corporation until their successors have been regularly elected and qualified. The said directors shall establish terms of office, select officers and all other related matters in the by-laws.

ARTICLE VII

AUTHORIZED SHARES:

This corporation shall have authority to issue a total of Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of capital stock of the par value of Ten Dollars (\$10) per share, all of these shares shall be of one class, and shall be designated as common stock.

ARTICLE XI

PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS:

There shall be no provision denying pre-emptive rights.
