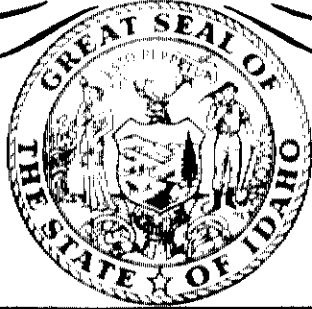



Whereas there is standing on the Tax Sales Register against Ben Campbell, tax to the amount of \$5.00 for property sold to the County for 1896 taxes, and whereas the same property was assessed in said year 1896 to L. F. Clifford, and taxes paid as shown by receipt No 300 filed therewith, it is ordered that said taxes against said Ben Campbell for said year 1896 be cancelled.

In the matter of the application by petition of M. J. Gray, C. K. Moon and L. B. Rice and sixty three others for the incorporation of the village of Saint Anthony; the Board finds the following to be the facts;

First.

That the metes and bounds of the proposed village are as follows, Beginning at the North east corner of Section numbered one (1), Township numbered Seven (7) North of Range numbered Forty (40) East of the Boise Meridian, and running thence South along the East section line of said Section numbered one (1) and across the Snake River to the South east corner of said Section numbered one (1) from thence west one half a mile to the half section line running north and south through said section numbered one (1) from thence North on said half section line across Snake River to the North bank of said Snake River, and from thence in a westerly direction along the north bank of said Snake River to the west boundary line of said section numbered one (1), from thence north along said boundary line to the north west corner of said section numbered one (1) and from thence east along the north boundary line of said section numbered one (1) to the place of beginning, and embracing

October 13th 1899

Six numbered one, two, three, four, five
six, seven, eight, nine and ten and the
South half of the South east quarter of
Section numbered one (1) Township Seven
(7) North, Range 40 E. & M.

Second.

That there is now residing within
said described Territory more than two
hundred bona fide residents.

Third.

That a majority of the taxable inhab-
itants of the within described Territory
have duly signed the petition praying
for the incorporation of said Territory
into a village.

Fourth

That the name they wish to assume
for said village is St. Anthony.

Fifth.

We therefore declare the within describ-
ed Territory incorporated the village of
St. Anthony and order that the within
order of Incorporation be entered upon
the records of Commissioners Journal,
and we hereby appoint C. C. Moon, M. J.
Halter, M. J. Gray, W. T. Jamison and A.
J. Castle, each being over 21 years of
age, a taxpayer and each an inhabi-
tant of said village for more than
one year last past, Trustees of said
village who shall hold their office
and perform the duties thereof un-
til the election and qualification
of their successors and in the manner
provided by law.
