

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

CONSUMER SALES COMPANY

WE, the undersigned persons, of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Utah Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

 $\underline{\text{FIRST}}\colon$ The name of the corporation is CONSUMER SALES COMPANY.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to carry on and engage in the sale and distribution of office supplies and equipment of every kind and nature, both at retail and wholesale, and to generally engage in the merchandising and distributing business, including all kinds and descriptions of goods and wares, and to perform sales, service and promotional work both for its own account and for the accounts of others.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

FIFTH: The corporation will not commence business until at least One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) has been received by it as consideration for the issuance of shares.

SIXTH: No shareholder shall have any prior or pre-emptive right to acquire any of the unissued shares of this corporation.

SEVENTH: The annual meeting of the stockholders for the election of directors and for all other business properly coming before such meeting shall be on the first Friday of January of each year, commencing on January 3, 1964.
