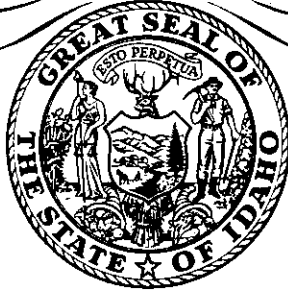

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

KELLOGG JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.,

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Third** day of **August** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and is duly recorded on Film No. **120** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for

perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

Kallogg, in the County of **Shoshone,**

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

NAME OF ASSOCIATION AND TERM

The corporate name of this organization shall be KELLOGG JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC., and its term of existence shall be perpetual unless sooner dissolved by a unanimous vote of the membership.

ARTICLE II.

PURPOSES.

The purposes and objects for which said corporation is formed are:

- (a) To form private non-profit, charitable corporation. /
- (b) To ~~affiliat~~ with the Idaho State Junior Chamber of Commerce, the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce and the Junior Chamber International, subject to constitutions and By-Laws of these organizations.
- (c) To promote civic service and community welfare by young men between the ages of 21 and 35 years, through constructive projects within the community.
- (d) To provide young men between the ages of 21 and 35 training and leadership in this organization for the purpose of becoming useful citizens.
- (e) To engage in any effort, business or engagement, within the State of Idaho, relative to the above purposes.
- (f) To buy, sell, transfer, exchange, encumber, own, hold real or personal property necessary to carry forward the above purposes.

ARTICLE III.

MEMBERSHIP

This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall not engage in business for profit, but shall be supported by gifts, bequests, benefits, contributions, and fees and dues paid by members. Membership in the corporation shall be governed and controlled as provided in the Constitution and By-Laws of this corporation. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal.

No part of the earnings, income, or receipts of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any individual, member, or members of this corporation. ✓

ARTICLE IV.


