## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OFF

JEN-RATH CO., INC.

5 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, FRED C. RATHBONE,  
6 TERRY JENSEN, and MICHAEL B. SWEET, of the State of Idaho, and all  
7 being citizens of the United States of America, and all being of  
8 full age, do, under and in pursuance of the general incorporation  
9 laws of the State of Idaho, hereby voluntarily associate ourselves  
10 together, and such other persons as hereafter become associated  
11 with us, into a body politic and corporate, to carry on the busi-  
12 ness and for the purposes hereinafter named:

The name of this corporation shall be JEN-RATH CO., INC.

II

16 The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as  
17 follows, to-wit:

- (a) To carry on the business of leasing automobiles and all forms of vehicles and equipment and all of the business necessary and incidental thereto.
- (b) To further carry on the business of buying and selling automobiles, vehicles, equipment and mobile homes and all the business necessary and incidental thereto.
- (c) To have and use a corporate seal which may be altered at pleasure.
- (d) To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage, and/or lease real and personal property; to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation, and to acquire, purchase, guarantee, hold, mortgage, own, vote, sell, pledge and/or otherwise dispose, deal in shares, bonds, securities and debentures and other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, domestic or foreign.
- (e) To appoint such officers, employees and agents as the business of the corporation may require and to allow them compensation.

1 (f) To enter into contracts or obligations of any kind  
2 or type essential, necessary or proper to the  
3 transaction of its ordinary affairs or for the  
4 purposes of the corporation.

5 (g) To conduct business in the State of Idaho or other  
6 states and territories of the United States and in  
7 foreign countries and to have one or more offices  
8 and places of business in or out of the State of  
9 Idaho, to to acquire, receive, hold, purchase, lease,  
10 mortgage, dispose of an/or convey real and personal  
11 property situate within or without the State of  
12 Idaho.

13 (h) To apply for, acquire, hold, use, own, operate,  
14 dispose of by sale or otherwise, mortgage, hypo-  
15 thecate, lease and/or sell and grant licenses in  
16 respect of patents, trademarks, trade names, in-  
17 ventions, improvements, processes, copyrights and  
18 licenses therefor.

19 (i) To execute, issue, and negotiate promissory notes,  
20 bills of exchange, bonds, debentures, negotiable  
21 instruments, securities and other obligations of  
22 this corporation, and to secure any of the same by  
23 pledge, mortgage, deeds of trust, or other hypo-  
24 thecation of any or all of the property of the  
25 corporation.

26 (j) In connection with the carrying on of the business  
27 of the corporation, to lend and advance money,  
28 credit, property of the corporation, and to render  
29 aid by guarantee or any other manner gratuitously  
30 or on such terms as may seem expedient, on open  
31 account, secured or unsecured, to any person, firm  
32 association or corporation.

33 (k) To purchase, subscribe for or otherwise acquire,  
34 own, manage, hold, use, operate, lease, mortgage,  
35 hypothecate, pledge, exchange, assign, transfer,  
36 sell or otherwise dispose of immovable and movable  
37 property of every kind and description, including  
38 shares of stock, bonds, indentures, notes, evidences  
39 of indebtedness and other securities, contracts or  
40 obligations of this or any other corporation,  
41 association or firm, and to pay therefor in whole  
42 or in part in cash, or by exchanging therefor stocks,  
43 bonds, or other evidence of indebtedness or secu-  
44 rities, of this or any other corporation, and to re-  
45 ceive, collect and dispose of the interest, divi-  
46 dends, and income arising from such property and  
47 to possess and exercise in respect thereof, all the  
48 rights, powers and privileges of ownership, in-  
49 cluding all voting powers of any stocks or other  
50 securities so owned, controlled, managed, or  
51 operated.

52 (l) To do generally any and all things necessary or  
53 proper in carrying on the business of the corpora-  
54 tion, and to enter into, make, perform and carry  
55 out contracts, leases and franchises of every kind  
56 and nature relating to or connected with the  
57 business or any phase thereof in which the corpora-

tion may be or is from time to time engaged upon, and to do everything necessary, proper or useful for the accomplishment of the objectives and principles herein enumerated, or necessary, proper or convenient to the benefit of the corporation for the furtherance of its business propositions.

(m) The foregoing purposes specified herein shall be construed both as purposes and powers, and shall be in nowise limited or restricted by reference to, or inference from the terms of any other clauses in this or any other article, but the purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses herein shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers, and enumeration of specific purposes and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner, the meaning of the general terms or of the general powers of the corporation.

12        The principal place of the transaction of business of this  
13 corporation and its post office address and registered offices  
14 shall be at Highway 30 West, Route 5, Nampa, Idaho, but the cor-  
15 poration may establish and maintain such subordinate and branch  
16 offices as may be hereafter decided or determined upon by the cor-  
17 poration, by or through its Board of Directors, whether in the  
18 State of Idaho or such other states or places as may from time to  
19 time be determined.

21       That the period for which this corporation shall exist  
22 shall be perpetually from and after the date of filing these  
23 Articles of Incorporation.

V.

25        That the total authorized capital stock of this corporation  
26 shall be ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00), divided into  
27 ONE THOUSAND (1,000) shares of the par value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS  
28 (\$100.00) each per share, all of equal classification, without  
29 priority one over the other, and fully paid and non-assessable.
