ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SMITH AND SON LAND AND LIVESTOCK INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That We, the undersigned, being three or more natural persons of full age, at least two-thirds of whom are citizens of the United States or of its territories or possessions, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, by and under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Idaho, providing for the formation of a general domestic business corporation, and we do hereby certify as follows:

Article I

The name of this corporation shall be:

SMITH AND SON LAND AND LIVESTOCK INC.

Article II

The general nature of the business and object and purpose proposed to be transacted and carried on by this corporation, to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, are as follows:

1.- To engage in any and all activities relative to the

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handling of any and all types of bees, including products and by-products thereof; to engage in any and all agricultural pursuits of any type or nature; and to engage in any and all activities of any nature related to the above mentioned purpose including particularly, but not limited to, the purchasing, handling, acquiring, leasing, manufacturing, processing, selling, transporting and distributing of any and all types of leaf-cutter bee boards, bee hives, and any and all products related thereto and the by-products thereof; the purchasing, handling, acquiring, raising, feeding, selling, transporting, and distributing of any and all types and kinds of livestock; and the purchasing, handling, acquiring, propagating, leasing, selling, transporting, distributing or otherwise disposing of any and all types of bees, any and all products related thereto and the by-products thereof.

2.- To engage in any and all activities relative to forestry and wood products of any type or nature, and any and all activities related thereto including particularly, but not limited to, the cutting, felling and logging of trees of any and all types and varieties in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho; the purchasing, handling, acquiring, manufacturing, processing, packaging, selling, transporting, distributing and otherwise disposing of all forestry and wood products and by-products thereof, including, but not limited to, forestry and wood products such as logs, boards, lumber, sawdust, wood chips, wood shavings, pressed logs, firewood, slab wood and wooden fence posts.

3.- To purchase, acquire, manufacture, lease, use, operate, sell, transport, distribute and otherwise dispose of any and all types of machinery and equipment of any nature, type

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or description which shall or might enhance the objects of this corporation.

4.- To purchase, acquire, improve, develop, divide, subdivide, lease, mortgage, exchange, trade, sell, barter, dispose of, and otherwise deal in any and all real property and any and every estate and interest therein, and choses in action secured thereby, judgments resulting therefrom, and other personal property collateral thereto, in making or obtaining loans upon such property, in supervising, managing and protecting such property and loans and all interests in and claims affecting the same, in effecting insurance against fire and liability and all other risks thereon, and in managing and conducting any legal actions, proceedings and business relating to any of the purposes herein mentioned or referred to; to purchase, lease, build, construct, erect, occupy, and manage buildings or machinery sheds, stores or works of every kind and character whatsoever; to finance the purchase, improvement, development, and construction of land and buildings belonging to or to be acquired by this corporation, or any other person, firm, or corporation.

5.- To purchase, handle, acquire, lease, exchange, trade, sell, barter, transport, distribute, dispose of, and otherwise deal in any and all personal property of every kind, type and description whatsoever.

6.- To purchase, handle, acquire, exchange, lease, trade, sell, barter, transport, distribute, dispose of, deal in and generally trade in, store, carry and warehouse any and all kinds of goods, wares, merchandise, provisions and supplies incident to or connected with or to do all things necessary or convenient which are incident to or connected with the general

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business of this corporation.

7.- To purchase, acquire, hold and dispose of stocks, bonds and other obligations of indebtedness of any other corporation; to purchase, acquire, hold and dispose of stocks, bonds and other obligations of indebtedness of any corporation, domestic or foreign, owning or controlling any articles which are or might be or become useful in the business of this corporation, and to purchase, acquire, hold and dispose of stocks, bonds, or other obligations of indebtedness of any corporation, domestic or foreign, engaged in any business similar to that of this corporation, or engaged in the manufacture, use or sale of property, or in the construction or operation of works necessary or useful in the business of this corporation, or in which, or in connection with which, the manufactured articles, products or property of this corporation may be used, or of any corporation with which this corporation is or may be authorized to consolidate according to law, and this corporation may issue in exchange therefor the stock, bonds or other obligations of this corporation.

8.- To purchase, subscribe for or otherwise acquire and to hold the shares, stock, bonds, or other obligations of indebtedness of any corporation, domestic or foreign, and to sell or exchange the same, upon the distribution of assets or divisions of profits, to distribute any such shares, stocks, bonds, or other obligations of indebtedness or proceeds thereof among the shareholders of this corporation.

9.- To borrow or raise money for any purpose of this corporation, and to secure the same and interest, or for any other purpose, to mortgage all or any part of the property corporeal or incorporeal rights or franchises of this corpora-

tion now owned or hereafter acquired, and to create, issue, draw and accept and negotiate bonds and mortgages, bills of exchange, promissory notes, security agreements, security interests, or other obligations or negotiable instruments.

10.- To purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire, hold, own, use, employ, mortgage, convey, and dispose of patent rights, letters patent, processes, devices, inventions, trademarks, formulas, goodwill, franchises, and property and rights of every kind, and to take over the whole or any part of the assets or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in or authorized to be conducted by this corporation, or owning property necessary or suitable for its purposes, and to pay for same in cash, in the stock or bonds of this corporation, or otherwise; to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the business or property so acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or incidental to the conduct of such business.

11.- To employ, terminate, and in any manner acquire employment of persons, or to contract with independent contractors, for the purpose of effecting the objectives of this corporation.

12.- To execute, make and enter into any contracts or obligations of any type or kind essential, necessary or proper to the transaction of its ordinary affairs or for the obligations of this corporation.

13.- To exercise generally the powers customarily exercised by business corporations, and particularly the powers provided by the laws of the State of Idaho, referring especially to Section 30-114 of the Idaho Code, in any State of the United States and throughout the world.

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14.- To engage in the business of transporting property of all descriptions for hire by motor vehicle or other means of conveyance as a private carrier, common carrier or contract carrier, and to acquire, own, operate, lease, and dispose of like businesses; and to purchase, acquire, lease, trade, sell, or otherwise dispose of any and all types of transportation permits for intrastate and interstate transportation including all public utility permits and all interstate commerce permits and interstate commerce certificates of public convenience and necessity.

15.- To build, construct, lease, rent, purchase, buy or otherwise acquire, and to use, operate, sell, trade, or otherwise dispose of a machine and repair shop in connection with the operation of a truck transportation service and to deal in parts of every kind and nature in connection with the operation of said trucking operation and repair shop and all other articles or merchandise of a kindred nature and to deal in articles and supplies generally dealt with by persons engaged in the operation of a machine and repair shop and transportation operation and business.

16.- To carry on any other business or do anything in connection with the objectives and purposes above mentioned that may be necessary or proper to accomplish successfully or promote the said objectives and purposes.

The foregoing clauses by reason of the specific enumeration of powers, shall not be held to restrict the power of this corporation to do any of the things within the purview of its general powers.

Article III

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

Article IV

The principal office of this corporation shall be located in the City of Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho; and Sharon D. Smith shall be the resident agent for this corporation in the State of Idaho for any and all purposes required by law until a Board of Directors should decide otherwise.

Article V

The amount of authorized capital stock of this corporation shall be FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) divided into FIVE THOUSAND (5,000) shares of common stock of the par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) per share.

The stock, as above mentioned, shall be of one class, namely, common stock, and shall all be voting.

Such stock may be issued from time to time without action by the stockholders, for such consideration as may be fixed from time to time by the Board of Directors, and shares so issued, the full consideration for which has been paid or delivered, shall be deemed fully paid stock, and the holder of such shares shall not be liable for any further payment thereon.

Article VI

The capital stock of this corporation, after the value for same has been paid in, shall not be subject to assessment to pay debts of the corporation, and no paid up stock and no stock issued as fully paid shall be assessable or assessed, at any time whatsoever.

Article VII

The private property of the stockholders of this corpora-

tion shall not be subject to the payments of the corporate debts in any amount or to any extent whatsoever.

Article VIII

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Corporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.

Article IX

The Board of Directors shall consist of three Directors, but this number may be increased or decreased from time to time as may be provided for in the by-laws of this corporation.

Article X

The Board of Directors by a majority vote shall have the power to repeal or amend the code of by-laws and to adopt a new code of by-laws.

Article XI
