ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ASN/SICE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned have voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation without capital stock pursuant to the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act (Idaho Code Section 30-301 et seq), and we do hereby certify:

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be ASN/SICE Alumni Association, Inc.

Article II.

That ASN/SICE Alumni Association, Inc., shall be a non-profit corporation and shall have no capital stock and shall pay no dividends or salaries to its incorporators, officers, or board members.

Article III.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

Article IV.

The purpose and objects for which such corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. To form an association of the alumni and interested persons from the former schools, Albion State Normal and Southern Idaho College of Education, which were located on the campus in Albion, Cassia County, State of Idaho.
- 2. To provide an annual bulletin to the membership and arrange an annual homecoming.
- 3. To carry on any projects agreed upon by the Association.
 - To preserve the heritage of the former schools.
 - 5. Said corporation is organized exclusively for

charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

- No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV. 5 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresonding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- 7. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable,

educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

Article V.

This corporation shall have one class of members, said memberships to be purchased according to procedure to be adopted in the Bylaws; such membership being available to anyone who attended or was associated with, either of the former schools; and such membership entitling each member to vote on all issues presented to the Association at the annual meeting or by mail.

Article VI.

The initial registered agent of this corporation shall be Keith Amende and the street address of its initial registered office shall be Albion, Idaho 83311.

Article VII.

The board of directors of this corporation shall consist of its officers and its elected directors, but in no instance shall the number of directors be less than five. The government, membership, officers, meetings and elections shall be prescribed by the Bylaws of the said corporation. The initial board shall have five directors, consisting of:
