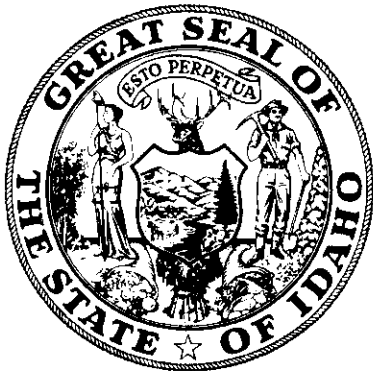

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

ASN/SICE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation without capital stock pursuant to the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act (Idaho Code Section 30-301 et seq), and we do hereby certify:

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be ASN/SICE Alumni Association, Inc.

Article II.

That ASN/SICE Alumni Association, Inc., shall be a nonprofit corporation and shall have no capital stock and shall pay no dividends or salaries to its incorporators, officers, or board members.

Article III.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

Article IV.

The purpose and objects for which such corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To form an association of the alumni and interested persons from the former schools, Albion State Normal and Southern Idaho College of Education, which were located on the campus in Albion, Cassia County, State of Idaho.
2. To provide an annual bulletin to the membership and arrange an annual homecoming.
3. To carry on any projects agreed upon by the Association.
4. To preserve the heritage of the former schools.
5. Said corporation is organized exclusively for

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1 charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for
2 such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that
3 qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the
4 Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of
5 any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

6 6. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall
7 inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members,
8 trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the
9 corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable
10 compensation for services rendered and to make payments and
11 distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in
12 Article IV. 5 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of
13 the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or
14 otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation
15 shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publish-
16 ing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on
17 behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any
18 other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not
19 carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) -
20 by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section
21 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresond-
22 ing provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or
23 (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under
24 Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the
25 corresponding provision of any future United States Internal
26 Revenue Law).

27 7. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board
28 of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the
29 payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all
30 the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the
31 corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organiza-
32 tions organized and operated exclusively for charitable,

1 educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify
2 as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)
3 (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

4 Article V.

5 This corporation shall have one class of members, said
6 memberships to be purchased according to procedure to be adopted
7 in the Bylaws; such membership being available to anyone who
8 attended or was associated with, either of the former schools;
9 and such membership entitling each member to vote on all issues
10 presented to the Association at the annual meeting or by mail.

11 Article VI.

12 The initial registered agent of this corporation shall be
13 Keith Amende and the street address of its initial registered
14 office shall be Albion, Idaho 83311.

15 Article VII.

16 The board of directors of this corporation shall consist
17 of its officers and its elected directors, but in no instance
18 shall the number of directors be less than five. The government,
19 membership, officers, meetings and elections shall be prescribed
20 by the Bylaws of the said corporation. The initial board shall
21 have five directors, consisting of:
