

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF STODDARD LUMBER COMPANY, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of § 30-1-1006 of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

The name of the corporation is Stoddard Lumber Company, Inc.

The following amendments to the Articles Incorporation were adopted by the shareholders of the corporation as of January 12, 1998, in the manner prescribed by the Idaho Business Corporation Act:

ARTICLE II of the Articles of Incorporation is amended by deleting it entirely and replacing it with the following new ARTICLE II:

"ARTICLE II

That the duration of this corporation is perpetual."

ARTICLE IV is amended by adding the following (b) paragraph to the end thereof:

"In addition to the foregoing, the purpose of this corporation is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which be incorporated under the Idaho Business corporations may Corporation Act. "

ARTICLE VII of the Articles of Incorporation is amended by deleting it entirely and replacing it with the following new ARTICLE VII:

"ARTICLE VII

The Board of Directors shall consist of one or more individuals, as elected by vote of the shareholders of this corporation.
