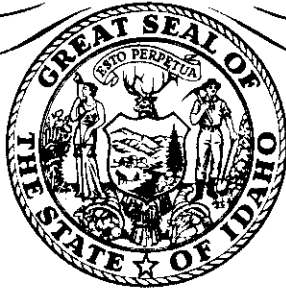

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

CENTRAL CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF BOISE, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Seventeenth** day of **August,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty,** and is duly recorded on Film No. **112** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise,** in the County of **Ada.** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

CENTRAL CHRISTIAN CHURCH

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, do hereby certify that we have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 11, Idaho Code, in manner following, to-wit:

ARTICLE I

That the name of the corporation shall be: CENTRAL CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF BOISE, INC.

ARTICLE II

That this corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

ARTICLE III

That this corporation is formed to carry out the work of Christ as set forth in the Great Commission, Matthew 28:19,20, and is formed for religious purposes only, to further the cause of Christ and His Kingdom, and is to be identified with the brotherhood known as Christian Churches (Disciples of Christ) to promote the development, growth and devotion of the membership in faith, experience and service; to provide^{worship,}/recreational and educational facilities; to erect buildings for the purposes aforesaid; and to these ends to have, acquire, hold, use, mortgage, lease, rent, dispose of, or assign and trust property, both real and personal, within or without the State of Idaho; to borrow or raise money for corporate purposes, and to secure the same by trust deed, mortgage, or other liens on any or all of the said property, or any portion thereof, of this corporation, whether at the time owned or thereafter acquired, at the pleasure of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation may do everything reasonably and lawfully necessary, proper and suitable or convenient for the achievement or furtherance of its purposes, and the foregoing statement of corporate aims and purposes shall be construed as a statement of corporate powers, aims, and purposes, not as restricting or limiting in any way the general powers of the corporation or their exercise or enjoyment as expressly or impliedly granted by the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

That the principal and registered office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is in Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VI

That the names and addresses of the persons to serve as incorporators are as follows:

all of whom are of legal age, members of the brotherhood known as Christian Churches (Disciples of Christ), and citizens of the United States of America; that the said incorporators shall act in the capacity of directors until the by-laws are adopted.

ARTICLE VII

That the term of the corporate existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VIII

That the management and title of all property of this corporation and the promotion, operation and maintenance of all of its affairs shall be specified in the by-laws.

ARTICLE IX

These articles may be amended, altered or repealed as provided by law and by-laws. All rights and powers conferred on directors, trustees, and members herein granted are subject to this reservation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the incorporators who are to act in the capacity of first trustees have hereunto set their hands this 16th day of August, 1960.


