

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

NORTHSIDE MISSION,  
INCORPORATED

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is NORTHSIDE MISSION, INCORPORATED

ARTICLE II

The place in this state where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is the City of Nampa, County of Canyon, State of Idaho. Registered office address: 515-20th Avenue North, Nampa, Idaho 83687 Registered agent in charge: Rev. Joe J. Esparza

ARTICLE III

This shall be a non-profit charitable corporation organized exclusively as an interdenominational ministry based on the teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ.

ARTICLE IV

The duration of NORTHSIDE MISSION, INC. shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The purpose of this corporation is:

- a. obtain by donation or otherwise and provide goods, commodities, clothing and services to the public at large in order to meet basic physical needs;
- b. to minister to spiritual needs of the community at large
- c. to perform and make available any other services and religious activities needed to operate a ministry meeting the physical and spiritual needs of the community;
- d. to solicit funds to continue the operation of the NORTHSIDE MISSION, INC. as an exempt organization under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code;
- e. to engage in any lawful act or activity for non-profit which corporations may be organized under the general Corporation Law of Idaho.

## ARTICLE VI

The corporation shall not have any capital stock and the conditions of membership shall be stated in the by-laws.

## ARTICLE VII

The activities and affairs of the corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors as stated in the by-laws. The number of directors which shall constitute the whole board shall be such as from time to time shall be fixed by, or in the manner provided in, the by-laws, but in no case shall the number be less than one.

## ARTICLE VIII

Meetings of the members and/or directors are to be held within the State of Idaho and the County of the majority of residence.

## ARTICLE IX

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational and ministerial/religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a tax exempt organization. This organization is not organized for profit and no part of the net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder.

## ARTICLE XI

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax exemption status under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
