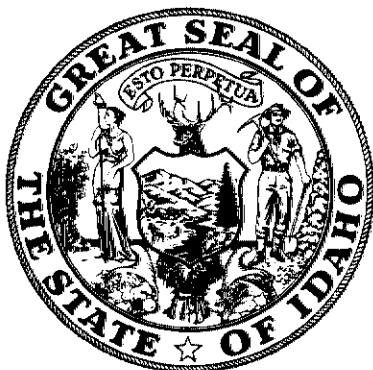

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

### NATIVE AMERICAN COALITION OF BOISE INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, have, the day and year hereafter appearing, voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under and pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 11, Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify;

#### I.

That the name of this organization shall be "NATIVE AMERICAN COALITION OF BOISE INC."

#### II.

Let it be known that the Native American Coalition Of Boise is a non-profit organization.

#### III.

The Native American Coalition Of Boise<sup>INC.</sup> is a permanent organization, it will be in perpetual operation.

#### IV.

The purpose and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To benevolently serve Urban Native Americans.
2. To preserve and protect Native American beliefs and practices.
3. To offer social activities between all Native Americans and all peoples.
4. To develop cooperation with state federal and local governments and local business and organizations.

The members of the Native American Coalition of Boise will be vested with the management of its own affairs. Membership will be made up of voting members and non-voting members. Voting members will be on the roles of a federally recognized tribe, and/or 1/4 Native American Ancestry.

VI.

The registered office of Native American Coalition Of Boise is 1407 Jefferson, Boise Idaho 83705, in care of John James, registered agent.

VII.

This corporation will meet Thursday of each week.

VIII.

These Articles may be amended by a majority of the membership attending any regular or special meeting of the membership called for that purpose according to the By-Laws of the corporation.

IX.

Duration of officers to last 1 calender year, January one to January one.
