ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SUNNY BENCH ESTATES PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

To: The Secretary of State State of Idaho

Pursuant to the provision of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, being a corporation duly recognized by the State of Idaho, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit cooperative association pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, Idaho Code 30-3-1 et. seq. and all laws amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this nonprofit Corporation is Sunny Bench Estates

Property Owners' Association, Inc..

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are:

a. To manage, operate, care for, and maintain and repair all non-public common easement and access roads within the Sunny Bench Estates, both those identified on the recorded plat of the property and those which are necessary to provide access to the lots within the property.

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- b. To acquire, own, hold, use, exercise and to the extent permitted by law, to sell, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate and in any manner dispose of rights, privileges, licenses, rights of way and easements necessary, useful or appropriate to accomplish any or all of the purposes of the Corporation,
- c. To purchase, receive, lease as lessee, or in any other manner to acquire, own, hold, maintain, use, convey, sell, lease as lessor, exchange, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of any and all real and personal property or any interest therein necessary, useful or appropriate to enable the Corporation to accomplish any or all of its purposes including, but not limited to, holding any personal or real property transferred to the corporation by Prairie Land and Timber Company;
- d. To levy assessments in such manner and in such amount as may be provided in the by-laws of this corporation and as may be provided by the laws of Idaho
- e. To do and perform, either for itself or its members, any and all acts and things, and to have and exercise any and all powers, as may be necessary or convenient to accomplish any or all of the foregoing purposes or as may be permitted by the Act under which the Corporation is formed in the State of Idaho and in any other State of the United States of America.
 - f. To engage in any other lawful activity.

ARTICLE III.

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is Prairie Land And Timber Company, Highway 95 North, Grangeville, County of Idaho, State of Idaho. The initial registered agent shall be Bryan Cash.

ARTICLE V.

Section 1. The Corporation is formed without any purpose of pecuniary profit to itself and shall have no capital stock.

Section 2. A person, firm, corporation or body politic becomes a member in the Corporation by:

a. Holding the ownership interest in any lot in Sunny Bench Estates as shown on the records of the County Recorder, Nez Perce County, Idaho. Each owner as defined in the Covenants Running with the Land shall become a member of the Corporation and each lot shall constitute one membership in the Corporation;

Section 3. The private property of the members of the Corporation shall be exempt from execution for the debts of the Corporation and no member shall be individually liable or responsible for any debts or liabilities of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI.

The name and post office address of the incorporator is Prairie Land and Timber Company, Highway 95 North, Grangeville, Idaho 83530.

Section 1. Except as limited elsewhere in these Article or in the bylaws of the Corporation, the business and affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in and managed and controlled by a Board of Directors and the officers of the Corporation shall be a president, a vice-president, a treasurer and a secretary. The offices of secretary and treasurer may be held by the same person.

Section 2. The officers of the Corporation shall—be elected, by ballot, by and from the members of the Board of Directors at such times and for such terms of office as shall be provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

Section 3. The number of directors of the Corporation shall be three (3). The initial directors of the corporation shall be C. H. Ketcham, Virginia Ketcham, and Bryan Cash. The addresses of the initial directors is c/o Prairie Land and Timber, Highway 95 North, Grangeville, Id 83530.

ARTICLE VIII.

The bylaws of the Corporation may define and fix other duties and responsibilities of the members and prescribe other terms and conditions upon which members shall be admitted to and retain membership in the Corporation, make provisions for annual and special meetings of members and directors and notices thereof, provide for methods of voting, quorum requirements and any other matters relating to the internal organization and management of the Corporation, provided that such provision shall not be inconsistent

with these Article of Incorporation or the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IX.

The Corporation may amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the total number of the members at any regular or special meeting, provided the notice of such meeting shall have contained a copy of the proposed alteration, amendment or repeal.

ARTICLE X.

Upon dissolution of this corporation, the assets shall be transferred pro-rata to the owners of the lots of Sunny Bench Estates.
