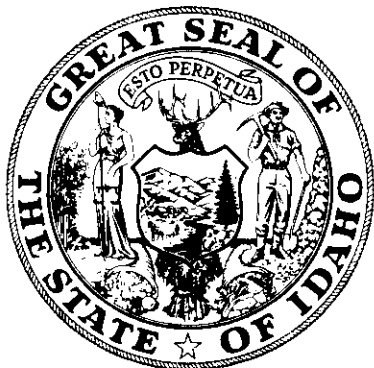

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
to
HORSEPOWER PROGRAM, INC.
A Non-Profit Corporation

COMES NOW the undersigned officers of HORSEPOWER PROGRAM, INC., a non-profit corporation, and do hereby file these Articles of Amendment for the purpose only of adding additional material to the original Articles and not altering the previously stated Articles in any way.

The additional wording is as follows:

ARTICLE IV

D. This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

E. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VI

However, if the named recipient is not then in existence or is no longer exempt from Federal income tax, or is unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, then the assets shall be distributed to an organization which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

That on June 11, 1983 at 12:00 o'clock noon there was a meeting of the members of this corporation at which time the above amendments were adopted by a unanimous vote and a quorum was present at the meeting.
