ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BEAR RIVER TV TRANSLATOR ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age and citizens of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under Chapter 10, Article 30, of Idaho Code, having the capacity to act possessed by natural persons and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of this association is:

BEAR RIVER TV TRANSLATOR ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this association is formed are:

- (a) To provide for its members better television service for Montpelier, Ovid, Bern, Bennington, and Georgetown, Idaho and the communities adjoining each of the aforementioned villages or cities.
- (b) To raise monies by subscription and to give rights and privileges to subscribers.
- (c) To maintain and operate equipment which has been, or may hereafter be, installed for obtaining a higher class and more exact television service, namely:

To erect and maintain booster relay station, or stations, and all equipment incident and necessary for the full development of television service in the area named in paragraph (a).

(d) To purchase, take leases, or otherwise acquire any lands, buildings equipment, or easements on property which may be requisite for the purpose of, or capable of, being conveniently used in connection with any of the objects of the corporation, and to borrow money, to execute mortgages, to sell and transfer real estate and to execute all necessary papers in connection with any and all of its operations and to secure the payment of monies so borrowed or obtained by the executing of mortgages and notes.

- (e) To possess all rights, powers and privileges and to assume the duties granted to all members of the corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, except such as are in conflict with the provisions of Chapter 10, Article 30, Idaho Code, as now are in existence or may be henceforth amended.
- (f) To raise money by subscription and to receive donations from its members and to utilize both membership fees and monies received by donation for better television service as set forth under paragraph (c) above.

ARTICLE III

The term for which the said corporation is to exist is the term of fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of its registered office in the State of Idaho is the city of Montpelier, Bear Lake County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall not issue capital stock but shall issue membership certificates, each membership certificate having a value of \$20.00. All members shall have equal rights.
