ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of  
IDAHO FUR AND BREEDING SYNDICATE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned more than three of whom are bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of, and do, by adopting these Articles of Incorporation, unite for the purpose of forming of corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

I.

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be and is Idaho Fur and Breeding Syndicate.

II.

PURPOSES.

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, sell or otherwise dispose of, and improve real estate of any and all kinds, including farm land.
2. To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, sell or dispose of water rights, for irrigation or constructing ponds for fish, fowl or fur bearing animals.
3. To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and operate, to sell or dispose of fish hatcheries or equipment used in connection with the same, to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, to sell or dispose of fish, and to engage in the general marketing of fish.
4. To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, sell or dispose of furs and fur bearing animals of every kind and description, and to engage in the breeding and raising the same for the general market or for private use.

- 5- To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire or dispose of warehouses for marketing furs and to engage in the business of marketing furs.
- 6- To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire or dispose of poultry, fowls and livestock of any and every kind, and to engage in breeding and raising the same for the general market or for private use.
- 7- To engage in the agricultural or horticultural industries in any and all of their branches.
- 8- To engage in tanning and otherwise preparing for market furs of every kind and description.
- 9- To engage in the manufacture of fur goods and clothing of any and every kind and description.
- 10- Subject only to the limitation herein expressed, to mortgage or otherwise encumber any or all property of the corporation, whether real or personal and wheresoever same may be situated.
- 11- To pay whenever earned dividends on its stock.
- 12- To lend or advance money or give credit to persons, firms or corporations on such terms as may be expedient.
- 13- To transact the business aforesaid or any branch of such business, and to promote or conduct any of the objects or purposes aforesaid, and to exercise all of the powers hereinbefore set forth, or any of them, both without and within the state of Idaho, or in any part of the world, and to have one or more offices outside the state.
- 14- To purchase, hold and own stock in other corporations.

III.  
PLACE OF BUSINESS.

The principal office shall be situate and the principal place where business shall be transacted shall be the city of Pocatello, County of Bannock, State of Idaho.

IV.

PERIOD OF DURATION.

The length of time for which this corporation shall be formed shall be fifty years from the date of the Certificate of Incorporation.

V.

DIRECTORS.

The number of directors of the corporation shall be five.

VI.

CAPITAL STOCK.

The authorized capital stock of the corporation shall be Fifty Thousand Dollars, which is divided into Fifty Thousand shares of One Dollar per share.

VII.
