


DESIGNATION OF AGENT, AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE PROVISIONS OF
THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Western Land Company, Limited, a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota, having filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho a duly authenticated copy of its Articles of Incorporation, does hereby, in pursuance of the laws of the State of Idaho, make this certificate, and does hereby designate Latah County, in the State of Idaho, as the County in which the principal place of business of said Corporation in said State of Idaho is and shall be conducted, and does hereby designate A. L. Morgan, residing in the city of Moscow in said Latah County, as the authorized Agent of said Corporation in said State of Idaho, upon whom process issued by authority of, or under any law of the State of Idaho, may be served, as provided by the Constitution and laws of the State of Idaho;

That the Western Land Company, Limited, desiring and intending to conform in all respects to the Constitution and laws of said state, and to avail itself of the rights, privileges, and immunities guaranteed by said constitution and laws, does hereby accept the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Idaho for all the intents and purposes contemplated by the provisions thereof, relating to such acceptance by other than municipal corporations. (Article XI, Sec. 7, Constitution of Idaho.)

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said Western Land Company,
Limited, has caused this certificate and acceptance to be
executed, acknowledged and delivered in its name and on its
behalf by its ^{vice} President, and to be attested by its Secretary,
and has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed at
Duluth in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota,
this 28th day of December, 1914.
