

# Articles of Incorporation.

State of Idaho,  
County of Washington, 1898.

Do George J. Lewis, Secretary State  
I, the undersigned, Edward S. Jewell, being  
dearly chosen by the First Methodist Episcopal  
Church, of Sauerbrig, Idaho, in conformity  
with the constitution and discipline of  
said Church, propose to incorporate under  
and Act of the Legislature of Idaho, entitled:  
"An Act for the Incorporation of Churches  
and Religious Societies." Approved March 5, 1898,  
and all Acts amendatory thereof, and that  
for the purpose of such organization I  
herby state as follows, to-wit:-

- (1) The name of such Corporation is, "The  
First Methodist Episcopal Church of Sauer-  
brig," by which name it shall be known  
hereafter.
- (2) The object for which it is formed is to  
carry on the business of said Society in all  
its forms. It shall have power to acquire, to hold  
to sell and to convey property, both real and  
personal subject to the discipline and the wages  
and Ministerial appointments of the Methodist  
Episcopal Church in the United States of  
America, as from time to time authorized  
and declared by the General Conference  
of said Church and the Annual Conference  
within whose bounds such Corporation  
is situated. Provided: That the secular

Affairs of said Corporation shall be managed & controlled by an Advisory Board, to be appointed or elected according to the discipline of said Church.

- (3) The estimated value of said property at the time of making this application is One thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars.
- (4) The title of the person making this application is a Class. Leader in said Church.
- (5) The location of his office is at Salebria, in the County of Washington, State of Idaho.
