### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, **LOUIS B. CLARK**, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**IDAHO CO-OP. FARM. ASSOC. INC.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **12** day  
of **August** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **1960** and  
is duly recorded on **12** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State  
of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and  
Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and  
successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for  
**non-profit associations**, from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

**Boise**, in the County of **Boise**,  
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooper-  
ative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

1                   ARTICLES    OF    INCORPORATION

2                   KIWANIS CLUB OF BUHL, IDAHO, INC.

4                   We, the undersigned, all full-age citizens of the  
5                   State of Idaho and of the United States, for the purpose of  
6                   forming a Corporation of the members of the Kiwanis Club of  
7                   Buhl, Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves  
8                   together as follows:

9                   FIRST: That the name of said corporation shall be  
10                   "KIWANIS CLUB OF BUHL, IDAHO, INC."

11                   SECOND: That the purpose for which said corporation  
12                   is formed are as follows:

13                   1. To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather  
14                   than to the material values of life.

15                   2. To encourage the daily living of the GOLDEN RULE  
16                   in all human relationships.

17                   3. To promote the adoption and the application of  
18                   higher social, business, and professional standards.

19                   4. To develop, by precept and example, a more intel-  
20                   ligent, aggressive, and serviceable citizenship.

21                   5. To provide through KIWANIS clubs, a practical  
22                   means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service,  
23                   and to build better communities.

24                   6. To cooperate in creating and maintaining that  
25                   sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the  
26                   increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and good will.

27                   7. To do all such things as are incidental or condu-  
28                   cive to the attainment of the above objects.

29                   8. To carry out the foregoing purposes the corporation  
30                   shall have the power to receive, hold and convey real and per-  
31                   sonal property, and to receive, hold and distribute gifts of  
32                   property of any and all kinds.

1                   THIRD: That the term of said corporation shall be  
2 perpetual.

3                   FOURTH: That the principal place of business shall  
4 be Buhl, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

5                   FIFTH: That there shall be no capital stock and no  
6 profit derived from said corporation. Each member shall have one  
7 vote only.

8                   SIXTH: The Board of Directors shall consist of the  
9 President, Immediate Past President, Vice President, Secretary-  
10 Treasurer, and seven (7) elected directors.

11                   SEVENTH: The power to repeal and amend the by-laws  
12 and adopt new by-laws is hereby conferred upon the directors,  
13 as well as upon the members, to be exercised by majority vote  
14 of said directors, or of the members, which may be provided in  
15 the by-laws.


