#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

G.E.T. INCORPORATED

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### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, the undersigned, being of full age and a citizen of the United States, do this day voluntarily form a corporation under the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, and I certify in writing:

ARTICLE 1 NAME

The name of the corporation shall be G.E.T. INCORPORATED.

### ARTICLE 2 PURPOSE AND POWERS

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Idaho Business Corporation Act and to possess and exercise all the powers and privileges granted by the Idaho Business Corporation Act or by any lawful powers and privileges incidental, so far as such powers and privileges are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion or attainment of the business or purposes of the corporation.

## ARTICLE 3 DURATION

Subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the corporation shall be perpetual.

# ARTICLE 4 REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located at Twin Falls, Idaho. The mailing address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho, County of Twin Falls, shall be 320 Second Avenue North, Twin Falls, Idaho 83301. Gary L. Garnand shall be the registered agent at the address set forth above.

## ARTICLE 5 CORPORATE STOCK

The aggregate number of common shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 100, which shall have no par value.

The common stock of this corporation shall be non-assessable; and the private property of the shareholders in this corporation shall not be liable for the debts, obligations or liabilities of this corporation.

### ARTICLE 6 INCORPORATOR

# ARTICLE 7 MANAGEMENT

The business of the corporation shall be managed by a board of at least three directors, except that if all the shares of the corporation are owned beneficially and of record by either one or two stockholders, the number of directors may be less than three but not less than the number of stockholders. A director shall hold office for the term for which he was named or elected, and the incorporator listed in Article 6 above shall serve as director until successors are elected and qualified, pursuant to the corporation's By-laws.

### ARTICLE 8 BY-LAWS

The initial By-laws of the corporation shall be adopted by its board of directors. The power to alter, amend or repeal the By-laws or adopt new By-laws, subject to repeal or change by action of the shareholders, shall be vested in the board of directors.
