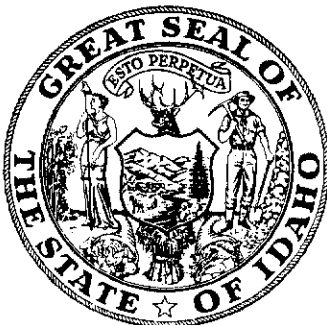

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT FOR

The following Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation for IDEAS were approved by majority vote of the membership **June 4, 1996**. Of the twelve (12) eligible voting members ten (10) members approved the Articles of Amendment and (2) two members abstained.

Article I

The name of this organization shall be Idaho Education Alliance for Solutions, Inc.

Article IV

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are not pecuniary profit, but shall be as an educational entity to serve local and state needs related to the learning and advancement of science, mathematics, technology and related fields.

The Idaho Education Alliance for Solutions is a consortium of schools, school districts, businesses, industries, institutions of higher education, professional organizations, research laboratories, governmental agencies, community groups, museums, associations and individuals---

3. By securing community support and participation by engaging in activities that include but are not limited to community action, information exchange services, school/industry collaboration, enhancement of student's competencies, improvement of science instruction in elementary schools, networking and liaison, improving teaching conditions, promoting leadership, recruitment, retention, and professional development of science teachers in rural areas and focusing state resources towards science and technology, all designed to accomplish the following objectives: ...
