

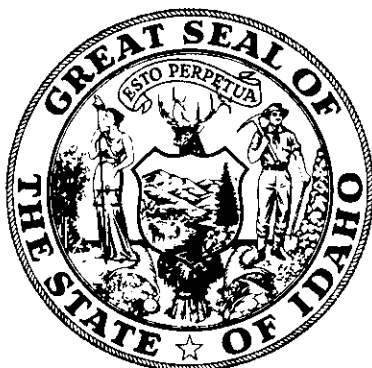
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, being three or more natural persons of full age, all citizens of the United States and residents of Preston, Franklin Co, Id, as members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, have associated, and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming an ex-servicemens corporate organization under the provisions of Section 30, Chapter 11 of the Idaho Code, relating to non-profit corporations.

ARTICLE FIRST

The name of the corporation shall be the Leonard C. Brostrom Memorial Post 10323. Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, Inc., and its principal office for the transaction of business shall be in Preston, Franklin Co, Idaho. The initial registered agent shall be: Don L. Hansen, 36 East 100 South, Preston, Idaho 83263.

ARTICLE SECOND

The corporation shall exist perpetually or until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE THIRD

This corporation shall not engage in any form of trade or commerce, nor, directly or indirectly, fix the price, or regulate the production, of any article of commerce or the produce of the soil, or the consumption of the same by the people, nor carry on any activity which will result in a remunerative profit to the corporation or its members. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the business pursuit, purpose and objects of this corporation are fraternal, patriotic, historical and educational; to preserve and strengthen comradeship among its members, to assist worthy comrades; to perpetuate the memory and history of our dead, and to assist their widows and orphans; to maintain true allegiance to the Government of the United States of America, and fidelity to its Constitution and laws; to foster true patriotism; to maintain and extend the institutions of American freedom; and to preserve and defend the United States from all her enemies, whomsoever.

ARTICLE FOURTH

The active and voting membership of this corporation shall at all times consist of and be confined to the active membership in good standing in Leonard C. Brostrom Memorial Post 10323 Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States with eligibility to, acquiring of, suspension from and discontinuance of membership being in accordance with the National Constitution and By-Laws of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States

ARTICLE FIFTH

This incorporated subordinate unit of the Veterans of Foreign Wars shall, at all times, remain under the jurisdiction of and be governed according to the Constitution and By Laws of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. In the event that any provision of this Certificate of Incorporation conflicts with the National Charter and By-Laws of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, such conflicting provisions shall be deemed null and void, and the National Charter and By Laws shall, at all times govern.

ARTICLE SIXTH

In the event of a dissolution of this corporation all of the assets shall be the property of the Leonard C. Brostrom Memorial Post 10323 Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States; and in the event of the simultaneous dissolution of this corporation and of the forfeiture of the charter issued by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States to said subordinate unit then, and in that event, title to all of the assets of this corporation shall pass to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States to be disposed of in accordance with the National By-Laws, rules and regulations of the said Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. At no time shall the assets of the corporation be distributed among the individual members thereof.

ARTICLE SEVENTH

These articles may be amended in the manner provided by the Idaho Code at the time of the amendment and the Constitution and By-Laws of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States.

ARTICLE EIGHTH

All meetings shall be conducted in no other language than the English language.

ARTICLE NINTH

The general officers of the corporation shall be as provided in the By-Laws. The number of directors shall be not less than three.

ARTICLE TENTH

All other matters pertaining to the organization and operation of the corporation not herein provided for shall be determined and fixed by the By-Laws. the INITIAL DIRECTORS ARE AS FOLLOWS.
