ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ALTRUSA INTERNATIONAL OF BOISE FOUNDATION OF STATE

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a nonprofit corporation of a nonprofit corporation ("Corporation") organized under and pursuant to the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation of Chapter 3, Title 30, Idaho Code ("Act"), adopts the following Articles of Incorporation ("Articles").

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is ALTRUSA INTERNATIONAL OF BOISE FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II NONPROFIT STATUS

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE III PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The location of the Corporation is in the City of Boise, County of Ada, and in the State of Idaho. The address of the initial registered office is 2902 Agate, Boise, Idaho 83705, and the name of the initial registered agent at this address is NANCY FINLEY SKY.

ARTICLE V PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and will be operated are as follows:

A. To receive contributions from the public and pay them over to educational organizations that qualify under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3), by way of example, but not limitation, Boise State University, Boise High School, University of Idaho, and Albertson's College, for such purposes to be determined by such

organizations, including, but not limited to, providing students with scholarships, grants, fellowships, or loans with recipients selected by such organizations;

- B. Charitable, religious, education, literary, or scientific activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt under Section 501(c)(3).
- C. To exercise all powers granted by law necessary and proper to carry out the foregoing purposes, including, but not limited to, the power to accept donations of money, property, whether real or personal, or any other things of value. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the Corporation to carry on any business for profit, to exercise any power, or to do any act that a corporation formed under the Act, or any amendment thereto or substitute therefor, may not at that time lawfully carry on or do.

ARTICLE VI LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings or the assets of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article V hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be for the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time.

ARTICLE VII NO MEMBERS

The Corporation shall not have any members

ARTICLE VIII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The number of Directors serving on the Board of Directors shall be fixed in accordance with the Corporation's Bylaws. Each Director of the Corporation shall, at all time, be a member of the Corporation. Other than the Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors, who are designated in these Articles, the Directors shall be elected by the

existing Directors of the corporation in the manner and for the term provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.
