

Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned resident freeholders of the County of Kootenai, State of Idaho, have this 13th day of December 1893 voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

First. That the name of the corporation is the Union Hall Association of Bonners Ferry, Idaho.

Second. That the purpose for which it is formed is to promote the social, religious and political welfare of the people residing in Bonners Ferry Precinct, Kootenai County, Idaho.

Third. That the place where its principal business is to be done, shall be the town of Eaton, Kootenai County, Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty (50) years from the date of incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of directors shall be three.

Sixth. That the election for directors ^{were} held in the building known as the "Town Hall" in the town of Eaton, Kootenai County, Idaho, on the 13th day of December 1893, at 8 P.M. of said day, and that a majority of the members of the association were present and voted at said election, and the following are the names and residences of those elected trustees:

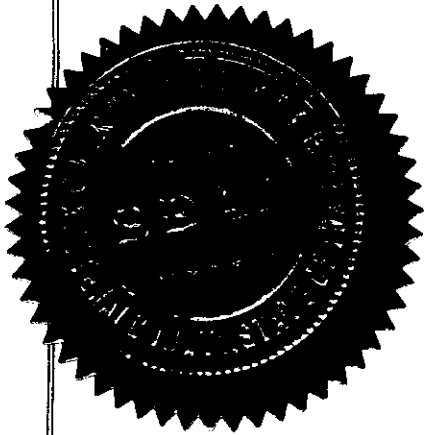
