The undersigned individual, duly licensed to practice law in the State of Idaho, and acting as incorporator under the Professional Service Corporation Act, Chapter 13, Title 30, Idaho Code, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Steven M. Stoddard, Chartered (hereafter "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of the corporation is to provide professional, namely, legal services and allied professional services.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have the power, and is authorized to:

- A. Engage in the practice of law and to render legal and allied professional services;
- B. Transact such business and perform such acts as may be necessary or prudent to facilitate the rendering of legal and allied professional services as may be permitted under the Professional Service Corporation Act;
- C. Transact such business and perform such acts as may be necessary or prudent to

facilitate the rendering of legal and allied professional services as may be permitted by the Idaho Business Corporation Act, Chapter 1, Title 30, Idaho code, to the extent not inconsistent with the Professional Service Corporation Act.

ARTICLE V

The class and aggregate number and par value per share of the shares which the corporation is authorized to issue is as follows:

ARTICLE VI

The limitations on the transfer of shares of the corporation are as follows:

No shareholder of the corporation may sell or transfer such shareholder's shares in the corporation, except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder of the corporation by reason of being licensed to practice law or render allied professional services in Idaho. A sale or transfer in compliance with the preceding sentence may be made only after the sale is approved, at a shareholders' meeting specially called for such purpose, by all of the outstanding shares of the corporation.

The limitations on transfer contained in this ARTICLE VI shall be set forth conspicuously on each certificate representing shares of the corporation.

The board of directors of the corporation are authorized to adopt, in its discretion, bylaws restraining the alienation of shares and providing for the purchase or redemption by the corporation of the corporation's shares.

ARTICLE VII

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1011 E. State, Boise, ID 83701, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Steven M. Stoddard.

ARTICLE VIII

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is one (1), and the name and address of the person who is to serve as director until the first annual meeting of shareholders, or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:
