RESOLUTION 98-5-1 MEMBERS OF TEN THOUSAND VILLAGES, INC.

AMENDING THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION TO DECLARE PURPOSES AND PROVIDE FOR DISSOLUTION ARRANGEMENTS IN COMPLIANCE WITH INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE REQUIREMENTS AND APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION REFLECTING SUCH CHANGES.

WHEREAS, amending the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation (the "Articles") requires a two-thirds vote of the members, represented in person, at any meeting duly called for the purposes of amending the Articles; and

WHEREAS, certain changes as described above require the amendment of the Articles; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned constitute all of the members of the Corporation and have unanimously approved said amendment; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the amendment of the Articles it is desired to restate the Articles to reflect said amendments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation be amended as follows:
- a. Section 2 shall be amended by the addition of subsection 2.6 to read:

"This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) Internal Revenue Code."

b. There shall be added Section 13, to read:

"Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code), or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the District Court of

the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."

- 2. The officers of the Corporation are hereby authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to implement the amendments of the Articles as called for in this Resolution and are further authorized to amend the Articles of Incorporation to reflect said changes and amendments.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately with the amendments to be effective at the time that all necessary documents are accepted by the Secretary of State for the State of Idaho.

AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of TEN THOUSAND VILLAGES, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 30-3-93, <u>Idaho Code</u>, the undersigned corporation, pursuant to a resolution adopted by its Members, hereby adopts the following Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation.

1. Section 2, <u>Purpose</u>, shall be amended to add a subsection 2.6 as follows:

"This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) Internal Revenue Code."

2. A new Section 13 shall be added to read as follows:

"Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code), or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."

The foregoing Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation correctly sets forth without change the corresponding provisions of the said Amendment as heretofore amended, and supplements and supersedes the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.
