ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

PANHANDLE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, INC.

Pursuant to Idaho Code Section 30-3-93, following constitutes Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation filed with the Idaho Secretary of State on July 29, 2004, by Panhandle Emergency Medical Services, Inc., an Idaho nonprofit corporation.

The corporation has no members. The following amendments were adopted by unanimous action of the board of directors, taken as of September 1, 2004:

1st AMENDMENT: Article 3 is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3

The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 ("Code"), and its primary purpose shall be to provide emergency medical services as an advanced life support provider within and throughout Bonner County, Idaho, including without limitation on-scene treatment, patient transport and community education.

The corporation shall at all times be operated exclusively as a support organization within the meaning of Code Section 509(a)(3), in support of the various Fire Protection Districts in Bonner County,

Idaho ("Fire Districts"), that have been created and are operating under the provisions of the Idaho Fire Protection District Law (Title 31, Chapter 13, Idaho Code).

2nd AMENDMENT: Article 7 is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 7

As authorized by Idaho Code Section 30-3-36, the corporation shall not have members.


3rd AMENDMENT: The first paragraph of Article 9 is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9

All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the affairs of the corporation managed under the direction of, its board of directors. In furtherance of the requirements set forth in Section 1.509(a)-4(g), a majority of the officers and directors of the organization shall always be elected or appointed by the controlling bodies of the said Fire Districts.

In all other respects, the Articles of Incorporation filed with the Idaho Secretary of State on July 29, 2004 are confirmed.
