ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

BE IT REMEMBERED:

That we, the undersigned citizens of the United States, of lawful age, and residents as hereinafter designated, have and by these presents do associate ourselves together as a body corporate, and to that end have, and by these presents do adopt, declare and publish and certify the following Articles of Incorporation:

I

That the name of said corporation shall be

MAX NADAULD OIL & TIRE COMPANY, INC.

II

- To buy, sell, lease, manufacture, construct, license and deal in and with machinery of every nature and description and more particularaly agricultural, industrial and mechanical implements, appliances, tires and accessories.
- 2. To buy, sell, lease, deal in, deal with, store and repair automobiles, aeroplanes, tractors, engines, motor boats motor vehicles and other vehicles of all kinds and descriptions, including trailers and bicycles, and all parts and accessories, and all parts and supplies used in connection therewith, and to carry on a general wholesale and retail merchandise business.
- 3. To buy, sell and deal in electrical machinery and appliances of all kinds and description.
- 4. To buy, haul, contract haul, sell deal in and deal with petroleum products, and to own, lease, operate and manage garages and filling stations for motor vehicles.
- 5. To apply for, procure and obtain by purchase or otherwise any and all kinds of letters patent, trade-marks, licenses and grants for inventions and improvements.
- 6. To purchase, acquire, hold, improve, sell, convey, mortgage and encumber real and personal property of every name and nature and to take securities for the payment of all sums due the corporation, and to sell, assign and release such securities.
- 7. To organize or cause to be organized, incorporate and reorganize subsidiary corporations and associations for any purpose permitted by law to the same extent as natural persons could do.
- 8. To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose with any person, firm, association or corporation, municipality, county or state.
- 9. To act as agent, factor, or consignee for any person, firm or corporation and to carry out all or any of the objects and purposes herein specified as principal, factor, agent, contractor, consignee, or otherwise.

10. To carry on any other lawful business whatsoever which may seem to the corporation capable of being carried on in connection with the above, or calculated, directly or indirectly to promote the interests of the corporation or to enhance the valuation of its property.

III

The term of existence of this corporation is perpetual, subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law.

IV

The principal place of business, registered office and the location and postoffice address of the registered office of this corporation shall be Idaho Falls, in the County of Bonneville, State of Idaho, P. O. Box 1862.

V

The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifty
Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars, divided into five hundred (500) Shares of the par
value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share, all of which shall be common
stock.

IV

The board of directors shall have the power to repeal and amend the bylaws of the corporation and adopt new by-laws at any meeting of the board of
directors. All by-laws shall be subject to amendment, alteration and repeal by the
stockholders at any annual meeting and at any special meeting called for such
purpose.

VII

The number of directors of said corporation shall be three (3), to be elected annually.

VIII

The executive officers of this corporation shall be a President, one or more Vice-Presidents, Secretary and Treasurer. The offices of any two may be held by the same person, except that of President and Vice-President. Such executive officers shall be elected by the board of directors at each annual meeting.
