One Thousand Nine Hundred and twenty-six and is duly recorded in Book 4-19 of Domestic Corporations, Records of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 4696 and 4871, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name stated in the articles, and for a term of five years, and as such are entitled to all the rights and privileges granted to, and subject to the limitations of Religious, Social and Benevolent Corporations, as provided in Chapter 196, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
THE CHURCH OF CHRIST, GOODING, IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:- That the members of the Church of Christ of Gooding, Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purposes for which directors have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, and we, the undersigned directors of said church, for the purpose of forming such corporation do hereby certify and declare as follows, viz:

The NAME of this corporation shall be the CHURCH OF CHRIST OF GOODING, IDAHO.

That the PURPOSE for which this corporation is formed is: To establish and maintain a Church at Gooding, Idaho, and in connection therewith suitable and customary organizations for the purpose of public worship and religious training; to take charge of the church building, estate and property, and the affairs temporalities thereof; to transact all business relative thereto; to acquire, own, hold and improve such property, whether real, personal or mixed as shall be necessary for the business and objects for which this corporation is organized; To take, receive, mortgage, alienate, or convey its real or personal property and do any and all things necessary or incident to the operation and carrying on of the business affairs of this corporation, as herein expressed in all its braches and for its best interests as may appear to its board of directors either now or in the future.

Pecuniary profit is not the object of this corporation and it is formed solely and only for religious, benevolent and educational purposes, and not for gain or private profit.

The PLACE where the principal business of the corporation shall be transacted is the City of Gooding, County of Gooding, State of Idaho.

The TERM for which this corporation shall exist shall be Fifty (50) Years.

The NUMBER OF DIRECTORS of this corporation shall be Three (3) and the names and residences of such who are to serve until the election of their successors are as follows, viz:

There is and shall be NO CAPITAL STOCK of this corporation, and there is and shall be no shares of stock.

The estimated value of the property of this corporation, at the time of making these articles of incorporation is FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS.

The DIRECTORS of this corporation shall be elected at the first meeting of members after incorporation, one-third of whom shall be elected for a term of one year, one-third for a term of two years and one-third for a term of three years, and thereafter at each succeeding annual meeting of the members one-third of said directors shall be elected for a term of three years.

That said directors hereinbefore named were duly elected at a meeting of the members of said Church, duly convened and held at the Church of Christ in the City of Gooding, County of Gooding, State of Idaho, on Friday, the 5th day of February, 1926, for the purpose, among other things, of electing a board of directors, preliminary to incorporation of said church under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to form this corporation; that a majority of said members of said Church were then and there present and voted at said election for the above named directors, as is more particularly set forth in the certificate and verification of the officers who conducted the election, hereto annexed and made a part of these articles.

We further certify that at said meeting of the members of said Church of Christ duly convened for the purposes hereinbefore set forth held at the Church of Christ at Gooding, Idaho, on Friday, the 5th day of February, 1926, a majority of said members being then and there present, who voted at such election, C. J. Eubanks was requested to preside, and J. H. Bevington to act as secretary, with which request they respectfully complied; that the meeting then proceeded to the election of three directors to take charge and management of the property, temporalities, and affairs of the Church of Christ of Gooding, Idaho, and to form an incorporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, in furtherance of the object for which the Church is founded; and that the directors hereinbefore named were then duly elected.

That before the holding of said election for directors as aforesaid, notice of the time and place of holding said election was duly given by Publication at least two weeks in the Gooding Leader, a weekly newspaper published in the City of Gooding, County of Gooding, State of Idaho, and also by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where said election was held for a period of at least two weeks prior thereto.

That they were respectively the presiding officer and the Secretary of the meeting of the members of the Church of Christ of Gooding, Idaho, mentioned in the foregoing Articles of Incorporation, which said meeting was duly convened and held at the Church of Christ at Gooding, in the County of Gooding, State of Idaho, on Friday, the 5th day of February, 1926 at 7:00 o'clock P. M., for the purpose, among other things, of electing a Board of Directors preliminary to the incorporation of the said Church under the laws of the State of Idaho; that the majority of the members of said Church were present at said meeting; that the affiant C. J. Eubanks presided at said meeting and that the affiant J. H. 
