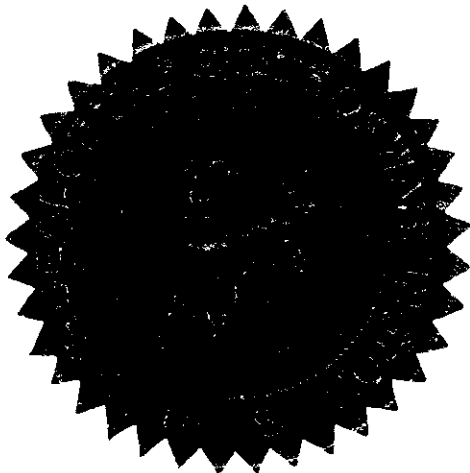

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ROBERT T. MERCER, INC.

We, the undersigned, ROBERT T. MERCER, ROBERT A. PURDUE, and WILLIAM MONTGOMERY, each of full age, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of the State of Washington, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and to that end do make, execute, and enter into these Articles of Incorporation in triplicate, as follows, to wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation hereby formed is and shall be the following:

ROBERT T. MERCER, INC.

ARTICLE II.

Place of Business

The principal place of business of this corporation, and the location and postoffice address of its registered office, shall be the following:

618 West Highland Drive,
Seattle, Washington.

ARTICLE III.

Objects

This corporation is formed for the objects and purposes of having lawful power and authority:

- (1) To operate a general building and contracting business.

2. To purchase, own, trade in, acquire, lease, hold, operate, insure, sell, manage, mortgage, and otherwise deal in and encumber, in any way, both improved and unimproved real estate of every kind and description.

3. To purchase, own, trade in, acquire, lease, hold, operate, insure, sell, manage, mortgage, hypothecate, and otherwise deal in and encumber, in any way, personal property, tangible or intangible, of every kind and description.

4. To construct, equip, erect, own, operate, promote, and finance, and do all acts that may be necessary in the financing of stores, buildings, plants, manufacturing establishments, warehouses, and work shops, and to do such things as may be necessary, convenient, and proper in the establishment, maintenance, and operation of any and all kinds of businesses.

5. To act as agent or principal in any and all ways.

6. To act as a liquidating agent in any and all ways.

7. To borrow money with or without security in any manner deemed proper at such time.

8. To have full power and authority to sell or encumber any and all assets, tangible or intangible, of the corporation.

9. To enter into leases, contracts, and agreements as may be necessary for the furtherance of the corporate business.

10. To acquire, own, and deal with in any way, trade marks, trade names, copyrights, and patents.

11. In general, to do any and all things, and to exercise any and all powers, which may now or hereafter be lawful for the corporation to do or exercise under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Washington or

any other laws that may now or hereafter be applicable to the corporation, or which are incidental to or convenient to be done in connection with any kind of business.

12. The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as to objects and powers and as in the furtherance of but not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the State of Washington, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or to restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation to do any and all lawful acts.

ARTICLE IV.

Capital Stock

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of and shall be evidenced by 500 shares of common stock with a par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per share. The paid-in capital with which this corporation will begin business shall be Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

ARTICLE V.

Time of Existence

This corporation shall continue perpetually.

ARTICLE VI.

Directors

The first directors who shall manage the affairs of this corporation until July 1, 1957, or until their successors are elected, will be: Robert T. Mercer, Robert A. Purdue, and William Montgomery.

ARTICLE VII.
