

The name of this Association'shall be "Owyhee Cattle and Horse Incorporated "Growers' Association, It shall be a non-profit, Co-Operative Association and membership shall be confined within County lines. The term of existence shall be fifty years from date of organization of this association. The principal place of business shall be at Murphy, Idaho. There shall be no capital stock, but membership certificates shall be issued in lieu thereof.

Article Two

Any American citizen owning and running cattle or horses within the bounds of Owyhee County may become a member of this Association by a majority vote of the Board of Directors and by payment of the regular membership fees of One Dollar per annum.

### Article Three

The object of this Association shall be to regulate the use of range, being the protection and conservation of the natural grasses, timber growth and watershed of our fast disappearing public range.

And to protect and stapelize the Cattle and Horse industry within the County and insist on the incoming Taylor act.

### Article Four

# Qualification of Voters

No person shall be entitled to vote at any election held by this Association unless he shall possess all the qualification required of electors under the general laws of the State. And a fully paid member of the association.

All members in good standing running Cattle or Horses are entitled to one vote in person. No voting by proxy allowed.

### Article One

The name of this Association'shall be "Owyhee Cattle and Horse Incorporated"

Growers' Association, It shall be a non-profit, Co-Operative Association and membership shall be confined within County lines. The term of existence shall be fifty years from date of organization of this association. The principal place of business shall be at Murphy, Idaho. The Board shall purchase the necessary goods and supplies for the office of the association and for the needs of the Secretary and Treasurer. The Board may set aside a reward fund such funds may be drawn upon for reward purposes only and by a majority of the Board.

The Board may employ or appoint one or more of their members to any special work or service and pay for the same from the funds of the Association.

## Article Nine

The Board may set \$250.00 for reward funds for information leading to the arrest and conviction of anyone killing, stealing or butchering horses or cattle of any member of the association.

#### Article Ten

The Treasurer shall issue funds only upon authorization from the majority of the Board of Directors and by check countersigned by Chairman of the Board.

### Article Eleven

The Chairman must call special meetings upon request of fifteen members of good standing and notice must be mailed by the Secretary to all such members not less than ten days previous to such meetings. Such notice to set forth the purpose and extent of the meeting. The Board may levy special assessments, provided that a maximum assessment of 5¢ per head shall not be exceeded in any one year.

Except on a majority vote of the Association Members at a special meeting called for this purpose.

The Board may employ such assistance as necessary to execute their duty as Directors.

The Board shall purchase the necessary goods and supplies for the office of the association and for the needs of the Secretary and Treasurer. The Board may set aside a reward fund such funds may be drawn upon for reward purposes only and by a majority of the Board.

The Board may employ or appoint one or more of their members to any special work or service and pay for the same from the funds of the Association.

## Article Nine

The Board may set \$250.00 for reward funds for information leading to the arrest and conviction of anyone killing, stealing or butchering horses or cattle of any member of the association.

#### Article Ten

The Treasurer shall issue funds only upon authorization from the majority of the Board of Directors and by check countersigned by Chairman of the Board.

### Article Eleven

The Chairman must call special meetings upon request of fifteen members of good standing and notice must be mailed by the Secretary to all such members not less than ten days previous to such meetings. Such notice to set forth the purpose and extent of the meeting.

# Article Twelve -

At any General Election or at any special election called for this purpose, the By-Laws of the Association may be ammended or suspended by a two-thirds majority vote of the members present.

## Article Thirteen

A copy of all brands of all members of the association is to be mailed to each member of the above association each year.
