ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States of America, over the age of 21 years, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the state of Idaho and we certify in writing:

I.

That the name of the corporation is Law Enterprises, Inc.

II

That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is to act as owner of certain business enterprises, and specifically to own drive inns, drive inn businesses, of all kinds and to make improvements on real estate and doing other business and contracting incidental thereto or in connection therewith, and doing and performing of any and all acts or things necessary, or proper, or inconvenient or incidental to the furtherance of the carrying out of the powers or the purposes herein mentioned; to purchase or to otherwise acquire for investment or for sale or otherwise, lands, contracts, for the purchase or sale of lands, buildings, improvements, or any other real property of any kind or tender or interest therein, and any property works or undertakings connected with the use or development of any property of the company within the State of Idaho, and within any other state or territory of the United States; and as the consideration for same, to pay cash, or to issue the capital stock, the debenture bonds, mortgage bonds or other obligations of the company; and to sell, convey, lease, mortgage, turn to account,

or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the company.

To manage, improve, develop, and turn to account any land or contracts for purchase or sale of lands acquired by the company, or in which the company is interested, and in particular, drive inns, restaurants, or other commercial establishments and businesses, and for constructing, altering, and improving buildings and homes, and for the letting on building lease, or building agreement, and for advancing money to, making subscriptions for, and entering into contracts and arrangements of all kinds with buildings, tenements and hereditaments and others;

To enter into any kind of contract or agreement, cooperative or profits sharing plans, with its officers or employees that the corporation may deem as advantageous or expedient or otherwise to reward to pay such persons for their services as the directors may deem fit; to purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire in whole or in part, the business, good will, rights, franchises, and property of every kind and to undertake the whole or any part of the assets or liabilities of any firm, person, association or corporation engaged in or authorized to conduct any business similar to any business authorized to be conducted by this corporation, or owing property necessary or suitable for its purposes and to pay for the same as hereinabove set forth.

To borrow money and to negotiate and make loans, either on its own account or as agent or broker; to issue bonds, debentures, notes or other obligations of this corporation from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, and/or convey in trust, any or all

of its property to secure the payment thereof; to discount, negotiate promissory notes, bills, drafts, and other evidence of debt and collect money due them through accounts receivable, notes, or otherwise; to enter into and make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and of every nature and for any lawful purpose without limitations as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state or government, or any sub-division, district, or department thereof; to acquire, and pay for in cash, shares of stocks, bonds, or notes of this corporation, or otherwise, the assets including the good-will of any person, firm, association or corporation, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligation or liability thereof; to engage in and conduct any and all kind of manufacturing business; these several clauses contained in the statement of purpose shall be construed as both purpose and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall be in no way limited or restricted, by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes, powers; and on recitation, expression or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed to be exclusive; but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

III

That the term for which said corporation is to exist is perpetual.

IV.

That the principal office and place of business of said corporation in the city of Blackfoot, County of Bingham, State of Idaho.

V.

That the number of directors of said corporation shall be not less than three nor more than seven, as determined by the stock holders or directors of said corporation from time to time.

VI.

That the amount of total authorized capital stock of this corporation is \$5,000.00 consisting of 50 shares of capital stock, par value of \$100.00 per share and the entire voting stock of this corporation shall be divided into equal 50 shares.

VII.
