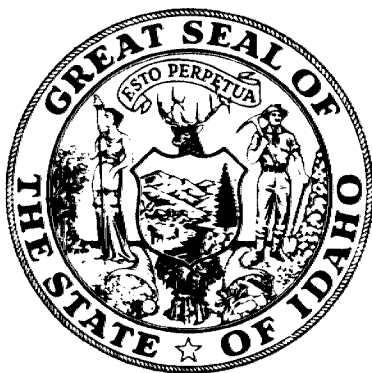

Amendment to Article 8 - Status under Federal Law

Delete the entire section and replace with the following:

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax as an organization described in Section 501 (c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (as amended or as subject to prospective amendment.)

This amendment was passed by a majority at a meeting on February 15th, 1989, a quorum was present. The meeting was held after members had received written notice. The notice contained a summary of the changes to be effected.
