ARTICLE I. Name.

ARTICLE VIII.
Provisions for Regulation of
Corporation's Internal Affairs.

- Section 1. <u>Meetings of Shareholders and Directors</u>. Meetings of the shareholders and directors of this corporation may be held either within or without the state of Idaho at such place or places as may from time to time be designated in the bylaws or by resolution of the Board of Directors.
- Section 2. <u>Bylaws</u>. The initial bylaws of this corporation shall be adopted by its Board of Directors. - Section 4. <u>Contracts in which Directors Have an Interest</u>. The bylaws of the corporation shall provide for the handling of contracts or transactions in which a director may have a financial interest, whether direct or indirect.
- Section 5. <u>Indemnification of Directors and Officers</u>. The bylaws of the corporation shall provide for the circumstances in which directors and officers of the corporation may be entitled to indemnification by the corporation.

ARTICLE IX.
Amendment of Articles of Incorporation.

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These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any respect conformable to the laws of the state of Idaho by an affirmative vote of more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the shareholders entitled to vote in a meeting of shareholders called for such purpose as prescribed by law.
