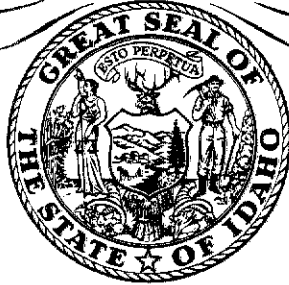

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

COEUR D'ALENE WOMAN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, RUTH SUSEDIK, CONNIE FOSTER ELFORD, ELINOR FISHER, LAURA J. EISENBARTH and LOIS B. MULLEN, all of whom are of legal age and citizens of the United States, have this day associated ourselves and do hereby, and by these Articles of Incorporation, unite and associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under Title 30, Chapter 10, Idaho Code, and we hereby acknowledge, enter into, and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Corporation shall be COEUR D'ALENE WOMAN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The period of the duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The location and Post Office address of the registered office in the State of Idaho shall be 3023 Fairway Drive, Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, 83814.

ARTICLE IV.

In furtherance and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, this corporation shall have the following purposes and powers:

1.

1. To promote and encourage the sport of bowling and, particularly, league bowling, within the area of Kootenai County, State of Idaho.
2. To provide for and encourage the interchange of ideas of mutual interest to members through meetings and programs and to promote a spirit of friendship and cooperative effort among its members.
3. To encourage the promotion and education of public opinion in the sport of bowling.
4. To provide a suitable place for the meeting of its members and the establishment of such facilities as to sustain interests of its members and secure intelligent action on the part of its boards and committees in the accomplishment of its general purpose.
5. To acquire, dispose of, or otherwise operate, maintain and control any and all types of property, or interest therein, necessary for the business and objects of the corporation.
6. To conduct these activities and achieve these objectives without pecuniary profit.
7. To do everything and anything reasonably necessary, suitable, proper, convenient or incidental to the aforesaid purposes, or which properly may be done by the corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to possess all proper powers, rights and privileges permitted to such a corporation by such laws.

ARTICLE V.

This corporation is not organized for profit and it shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VI.

Corporations, associations and co-partnerships, as well as persons, may become members of this corporation, subject to any restriction thereof by the Constitution or laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VII.

The rights and interests of all members shall be equal and no member can have or acquire a greater interest than any other member. Membership

certificates shall be issued to each member and shall not be assignable. No membership shall be granted nor any membership certificate transfer approved except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as may be prescribed by the by-laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

The private property of the members shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts, liabilities or obligations to any extent whatever.

ARTICLE IX.

In the event of dissolution of this corporation, any of its assets not required by law to be otherwise applied or distributed shall be distributed to any successor or other organization having purposes similar to the purposes of this corporation, as may be determined by the Board of Directors.
